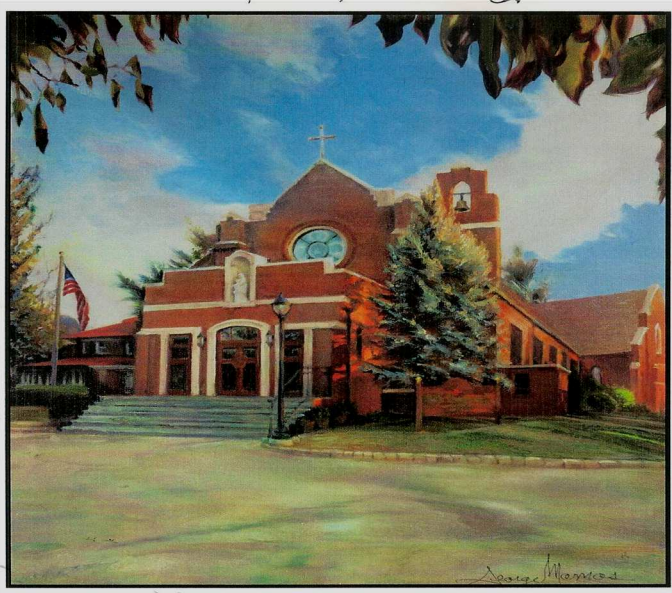

Dear College Students,

I am writing to you who are going away to college for the first time, as well as to those of you who are returning for another year. I have a nephew who is returning to his second year at Scranton University and two nieces who are going into their first year at Villanova University. So I am writing to all of you what I want to say to the three of them. So take it as advice from an uncle who loves you and who wants only the best for you!

Keep your family's values when it comes to sexuality. If you know a behavior to be unacceptable by your parents and grandparents at home, then it remains unacceptable at college. The rules regarding the appropriateness of sex in marriage only, continue to apply at college – there is no exemption for one's college years!

Keep your family's values when it comes to religion. The atmosphere at many college campuses is to disregard the importance of religion in one's life. Don't give in to that influence, in fact, be a counter-cultural influence on your campus. Speak up about what you believe and don't be intimidated by other students or by your professors. Get involved in campus ministry activities, and most importantly continue to go to Mass. The campus ministry activities will provide you with great opportunities to use the energy and strength and vitality of your youthfulness for the benefit of others – and you'll also discover how fulfilling that is! And as for Mass, you'll be keeping focused on God and you'll meet great people there. To say nothing of the fact that your parents and grandparents will be incredibly proud of you!

Explore all the wonderful things that college life have to offer you – all the wonderful things that are legal, moral, ethical and safe. Leave the others behind. There are a lot of ways to enjoy college without getting into trouble.

Make good decisions.

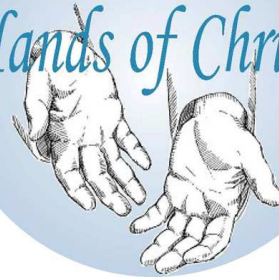

WASHINGTON—Cardinal Seán O'Malley,
OFM Cap., archbishop of Boston and chairman
