# Day 1 Monday, October 14: Depart USA

Depart New York's JFK International Airport via EL AL Israel Airlines for our pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served on board. (D)

# Day 2 Tuesday, October 15: Arrive in Tel Aviv | Mount Carmel | Sea of Galilee

This morning, arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport. Proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet our Peter's Way tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our private touring bus and we will be on our way to Mount Carmel. Pass by Caesarea by the Sea, site of a flourishing early Christian community, where the ruins of Turkish, Crusader, and Roman Civilizations are still visible. Biblically, St. Paul was imprisoned here before being sent to Rome for trial. It was here also that St. Peter baptized the first Gentiles. Continue to Mount Carmel. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

After lunch, we will visit Stella Maris Carmelite Monastery located on the slopes of Mount Carmel, dedicated to the prophet Elijah and Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Celebrate Mass at the altar above Elijah's cave, where the Old Testament prophet is believed to have lived. After Mass, continue by coach to the unforgettable Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight at our hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B.D)

# Day 3 Wednesday, October 16: Nazareth I Cana I Magdala

## Theme: The Annunciation

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we'll visit Nazareth, the village in which Jesus grew up and lived most of his life. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation. After Mass, visit St. Joseph's workshop and explore the magnificent Basilica of the Annunciation, Mary's Well, and the Church of the Old Synagogue, which marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. We will gather at the Grotto of the Annunciation just before noon to pray the Angelus in commemoration of the Angel's Annunciation to Mary and reflect on Her response of "yes' to God. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

After lunch, continue to Cana to visit the Franciscan Wedding Church, built in the nineteenth century over ruins from Jesus' time. See the display of stone jars and reflect on Jesus' first miracle of changing water into wine. Couples will have an opportunity to renew their wedding vows. Then we will return to Magdala, for an in-depth tour of the archeological park with its first-century synagogue and the Magdala Stone, one of the most significant recent archaeological finds in the Holy Land. See the Duc In Altum spiritual center that houses the Women's Atrium, Boat Chapel, Mosaic Chapels, and Encounter Chapel. Dinner and overnight at our hotel by the Sea of Galilee.

#### Day 4 Thursday, October 17: Around the Sea of Galilee Theme: The Ministry of Christ in Galilee

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will explore the Sea of Galilee and the area of Jesus' public ministry. Begin with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, where the Gospels come to life as we imagine when Jesus walked on the water (John 6:19-21), calmed a storm (Matt. 8:23-26), and showed the disciples miraculous catches of fish (Luke 5:1-8: John 21:1-6), We'll visit Tabgha, a popular fishing spot for locals because of its famous "seven springs" (Heptapegon). Tabgha is the traditional location for the calling of the disciples. Here, Jesus walked along the shore and called out to Simon, Peter, and Andrew, who were casting their nets into the sea. Visit the Church of the Multiplication and see the Byzantine mosaic of the loaves and fishes and the Church of the Primacy. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Primacy. From there we will go to Capernaum, the town of Jesus, to visit the house of Peter's mother-in-law and the first-century synagogue where Jesus taught and performed miracles. From there we'll ascend the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

Drive north to explore the upper regions of Israel to the foot of Mount Hermon, overlooking Syria and the Road to Damascus, where Jesus appeared to Paul. Visit Caesarea Philippi and reflect in the place where Jesus looked at his disciples and said, "...But who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15).

Dinner and overnight at our hotel by the Sea of Galilee.. (B,D)

# Day 5 Friday, October 18: Mount Tabor | Jordan Valley | Jericho |

# Jerusalem

## Theme: The Transfiguration

Breakfast at our hotel, followed by check-out. We'll leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to Mount Tabor, sight of the ancient battle of the Israelite General Barak against the Canaanites and the sacred location where Jesus, with Peter, James and John as witnesses, was gloriously transfigured. At the foot of the mountain, we'll take taxis to the top, where we will experience an utterly commanding view of the Galilee region. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Transfiguration. Then, continue along the Jordan Valley and marvel at the desert blooming with beautiful flowers, fruits, and vegetation. We will continue to Jericho. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

After lunch we'll explore Jericho, home of Joshua, Elijah's spring, and the Mount of Temptation. We will stop at a Sycamore tree and recall Jesus' encounter with Zacchaeus the Publican (tax collector). After a short visit at some of the ancient archeological ruins (the ancient Gates of Jericho [10,000 BC]), we will travel a short distance to a panoramic site traditionally venerated as the Mount of Temptation, the place of Jesus' temptations by the devil. Return to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem. (B.D)

Day 6 Saturday, October 19: Mount of Olives I Gethsemane I Mount Zion Theme: Palm Sunday & the Agony in the Garden

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with Mass at Bethphage Church, which commemorats the place where Jesus began his Palm Sunday journey riding on a donkey. After Mass, we will drive to top of Mount of Olives, where the summit offers a magnificent view of the Old City. This visit reminds us of Jesus' last hours in prayer and anguish as He faced His passion and death. See the site of the Ascension of Our Lord and the Church of Pater Noster. Walking down the Palm Sunday Road to Jerusalem, we will visit the moving chapel of Dominus Flevit, the location where Jesus wept as he looked down at the City of Jerusalem. Continue walking along the Hosanna Road to the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit the Church of All Nations to pray at the "Rock of Agony," a section of bedrock identified as the place where Jesus prayed alone in the garden on the night of His arrest. Group stop for lunch (cost not included)

We'll drive to Mount Zion to visit the House of the High Priest, the Church of St. Peter in Galicantu, Dormition Abbey, and the traditional site of the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper and descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. Archeologists believe that this is also the site of the first congregation of the Early Church, and therefore the site where the first deacons were "selected by the community" and "ordained by the Apostles.' Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem.

# Day 7 Sunday, October 20: Jordan River I Qumran I Dead Sea Theme: The Wilderness

Early breakfast at our hotel. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. Then we'll journey to the Judean Wilderness and go to the Jordan River, the traditional site of the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist (Matthew: 3:13-17). It is also considered to be the place where the Israelites crossed the Jordan River and Elijah the Prophet ascended to heaven. After our visit we'll continue to explore Qumran, where the hidden library of the Essenes, which contained the Dead Sea Scrolls, was found in 1947. Group stop for lunch (cost not included)

Next, we will go to the Dead Sea, considered the world's most ancient spa, for an opportunity to float! On our way back to Jerusalem we will stop at Bethany, where Martha, Mary and Lazarus welcomed Jesus in their home. Visit the traditional tomb of Lazarus. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B.D)

## Day 8 Monday, October 21: Bethlehem I Shepherds' Field I Ein Karem Theme: The Nativity & The Visitation

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a drive to the hills of Bethlehem. Visit Shepherds' Field, where we will see caves that were used as stables in the time of Jesus' birth. The highlight of our time in Bethlehem will be a visit to the traditional birthplace of Jesus in the Basilica of the Nativity. Here, the Prince of Peace was born! Celebrate Mass in one of the grotto chapels of the Basilica of the Nativity. Free time for shopping in Manger Square. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

This afternoon we'll visit Ein Karem, home of Zachariah and Elizabeth, and birthplace of St. John the Baptist. See the Church of the Visitation, one of the most artistic in the Holy Land. Verses from the Magnificat are engraved on the columns of the church. On the wall opposite are ceramic tablets bearing verses from the Magnificat in forty-two different languages. Return to the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Centre with the remainder of the afternoon free to rest and freshen up for dinner or explore Jerusalem on your own. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem.

# Day 9 <u>Tuesday. October 22: Old City & Temple Mount | Israel Museum</u> Theme: Early Years in Jerusalem & The Visitation After breakfast at our hotel, celebrate Mass at St. Francis Ad Coenaculum Monasterv in

Jerusalem. After Mass, we will explore the Old City of Jerusalem and walk to the area of the Temple Mount. Above the Temple foundations, we'll see El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. Continue to the Western Wall (Ophel Hill) and walk through the narrow alleyways and streets of Jerusalem, seeing the Pinnacle of the Temple (Gate of Hulda). It was here that the disciples preached and baptized after Pentecost. We will also visit the Jewish Quarter. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

After lunch we'll visit the Israel Museum, which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls, important to our understanding and appreciation of the Bible. Explore an enlightening model of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the days of Jesus. Return to the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Centre with the remainder of the afternoon free to rest or explore Jerusalem on your own. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

# Day 10 Wednesday, October 23: Via Dolorosa I Emmaus I Return to the USA

## Theme: The Crucifixion & The Resurrection

Early morning, we'll enter the Old City of Jerusalem through St. Stephen's Gate. Continue on foot to the convent of the Sisters of Zion and to see the Lithostrotos in the Chapel of the Flagellation, where Jesus was tried and condemned to death by crucifixion. We'll walk along the Via Crucis down to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Celebrate early morning Mass at the Tomb of Our Lord or on Calvary in the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre. After Mass we'll have a guided visit of the basilica and the extraordinary opportunity to see the empty tomb! Return to our hotel for breakfast and freshen up. Late morning, we'll return to the Old City to visit the Crusader Church of St. Anne and explore the Pool of Bethesda. Independent lunch in Jerusalem.

Visit one of the traditional Emmaus sites and recall the story in Luke's Gospel where Jesus appeared to His disciples on the road after the Resurrection. Continue to Hotel Ambassador for dinner. Following dinner, we'll be transferred to Tel Aviv International Airport for our redeye return flight to New York. Overnight on board.

# Day 11 Thursday, October 24: Arrive in the USA

Early morning, arrive in New York's JFK International Airport, overflowing with life-changing memories from our pilgrimage.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.
