DAY 1 Wednesday, November 13: Depart USA

Depart New York's JFK International Airport on our overseas journey to the Czech Republic. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the transatlantic flight.

DAY 2 Thursday, November 14: Welcome to Prague!

Arrive at Prague International Airport, proceed through passport control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tour Manager as we exit Customs. Board our private deluxe touring bus and we will be on our way to the enchanting Czech capital of Prague. Enjoy an orientation tour of the "City of 100 Spires." A stop will be made at the Carmelite Church of Our Lady of Victorious, where the famous sculpture of the Infant Jesus is preserved and venerated. It is said that the Infant Jesus of Prague has miraculous curing powers and that it was the protector of the city against plague and the destruction in the 30 Years' War. Celebrate Mass at the Shrine. Independent lunch.

Check-in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Prague.

DAY 3 Friday, November 15: Highlights of Prague

Breakfast at our hotel. Today we'll have a guided walking tour of Prague, including the Castle District (Hradcany). Explore spectacular Prague Castle and visit St. Vitus Cathedral, where you'll see the tomb of St. Wenceslas and former rulers of the Czech Kingdom. Stroll through Mala Strana with its amazing architectural buildings. Continue to statue-lined Charles Bridge which spans the Vltava River, connecting the castle on one side with most of the original village on the other side. Continue to Old Town Square best known for its Astronomical Clock, showing the central European time, Czech time, and Babylonian time. At the stroke of every hour, wooden doors above the clock open to show the 12 apostles rotating as they look down. The doors shut, followed by flaps and a crow from a rooster which symbolizes the three denials of Christ and a reminder to us to speak

the truth. Celebrate Mass at the Tyn Church.

Independent lunch and free afternoon in the old town square. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Prague.

DAY 4 Saturday, November 16: Melk Abbey | Vienna

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll depart Prague to Vienna (four-hour bus ride). En route we'll stop to visit Melk Abbey. Independent lunch upon arrival. We'll have a guided visit of the abbey, crowning the rocky hill overlooking the Danube. Melk is the best sample of Baroque architecture in Austria. Its library contains over 80,000 books and 2,000 manuscripts on religious subjects. Celebrate Mass at the Abbey Church. After Mass, we'll continue our journey to Vienna, Austria's capital. (B,D)

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna.

DAY 5 Sunday, November 17: Highlights of Vienna

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll visit St. Stephen's Cathedral (Stephansdom), Austria's most eminent Gothic edifice and mother church of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Vienna. Famous for its multi-colored tile roof, Stephansdom is one of the city's most recognizable symbols. Celebrate Mass at St. Stephen's Cathedral. After Mass, we'll have a walking tour as we pass by Hofburg Imperial Palace, former residence of the imperial family; the Capuchin Church containing the Imperial Crypt, the Broque Church of St. Peter's (Peterskiche); and the (die Wiener Pestsaule), or the Holy Trinity Column. Independent lunch.

Enjoy a panoramic tour as we pass the Karlskirche (Church of St. Charles), considered the most outstanding baroque church in Vienna, and Belvedere Palace, former summer residence of Prince Eugene of Savoy. Drive around the Vienna Ring Road, located on sites where medieval city fortifications once stood. We'll pass the Vienna Opera, Museums, House of Parliament, City Hall, and the Burgtheater. Continue to visit the Schönbrunn Palace, the summer residence of the Habsburg rulers. We will walk through the entire piano nobile of the palace. In addition to the private apartments of Franz Joseph and Elisabeth, the southfacing reception rooms, and the State Apartments, we will also get to see the rooms occupied by Maria Theresa. (B,D)

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna.

DAY 6 Monday, November 18: Free Day in Vienna

Breakfast at our hotel. Enjoy a free day to enjoy Vienna on your own. Perhaps,

you'll visit Mozart House and Museum or the House of Music, where visitors can feel, see, and listen to music - a truly unique experience that you won't want to miss. You can attend a lunchtime concert at the Town Hall "Christkindlmarkt" and take part in the festival activities. Enjoy an independent Viennese-style lunch. We recommend you try the famous Café Demel, Café Hofburg, or Café Balthasar, all within reach.

Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Vienna.

DAY / <u>Tuesday, November 19: Mariazell | Mondsee | Salzburg</u>

Breakfast at our hotel. Today, we'll leave Vienna and drive across the spectacular forested mountains, rushing streams, and small market towns to the little village of Mariazell, a favorite Viennese resort. Visit the Shrine of Mariazell. The shrine is a famous pilgrimage center in Austria dedicated to the Blessed Mother. A monk, who built a small shelter or "Zell" in the woods to protect a statue of the Blessed Mother, founded the shrine in 1157. Today, Mariazell Baroque church has been rebuilt several times in different architectural styles and still houses the old statue. Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of Mariazell. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, we'll leave Mariazell and drive along the Austrian Lake District with marvelous views of Salzkammergut to the Baroque city of Salzburg, a jewel set on the beautiful banks of the Salzach River. En route, we'll stop in Mondsee and visit the basilica where the wedding of Maria and Captain von Trapp was filmed in The Sound of Music. Check-in at our hotel in Salzburg. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Salzburg. (B,D)

DAY 8 Wednesday, November 20: Highlights of Salzburg

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will be transferred to the Shrine of Maria Plain in Salzburg. Celebrate Mass at the Shrine. After Mass, we will have a guided tour of Salzburg's sights along Getreidegasse, the city's pedestrian street, lined with authentic 17th and 18th century buildings including the house where Mozart was born. View Monchsberg with the fortress "Hohensalzburg," which overlooks the city. Built into the side of Monchsberg is the Salzburg Festspielhaus, home of the famous Salzburg Festival Operas. See Residenzplatz, the center square of Salzburg dominated by the largest Baroque fountain north of the Alps. Immerse yourself in the history, architecture, and significance of this astonishing cathedral on our guided tour.

Independent lunch. Free afternoon to enjoy the famous "Christkindlmarkt" at the Cathedral Square.

Enjoy a festive dinner at St. Peter Stiftskulinarium with its famous Mozart Dinner Concert. (B,D)

Overnight at our hotel in Salzburg.

DAY 9 Thursday, November 21: Ettal Abbey | Neuschwanstein

Castle | Munich

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Salzburg for Munich. En route we'll stop at the Benedictine Abbey of Ettal or Weiskirche for Mass. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, we'll explore King Ludwig's majestic castle, Neuschwanstein. This dream-like fortress was built in 1869 based on sketches of a theatrical decorator. Return to the times of Wagner as we visit the royal apartments decorated with scenes from German sagas and operas; the throne rooms and music halls, with fine candelabras and chandeliers; King Ludwig's unique bedroom with artistic wood carvings; and an artificial grotto that recalls opera themes of his former friend and composer Richard Wagner. After our visit we'll continue to Munich for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Munich.

DAY 10 Friday, November 22: Dachau | Munich

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll take an excurison to visit Dachau (onehour bus ride). Visit the Museum in the former administrative buildings of the camp, which gives the visitor an idea of the Nazi concentration camp system. Time will be given for prayer and reflection in Dachau. Celebrate Mass at the Carmelite Convent in Dachau. Independent lunch.

We'll continue to Munich. Our orientation tour will include the Marienplatz, the world famous "Glockenspiel," and the twin-towered Frauenkirche (Church of Our Lady). Continue on to the Asamkirche, dedicated to the martyr St. John Nepomuk. This church was erected in the late 1700's and is a splendid example of fine Rococo design. Pass by the Residenz, which served as the seat of government and residence of the Bavarian dukes, electors, and kings from 1508 to 1918. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Munich. (B,D)

DAY 11 Saturday, November 23: Return to the USA

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll be transferred to Munich Airport for our return flight to the USA.

This pilgrimage entails a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Participants must be medically and physically fit for this type of travel. Package inclusions do not always meet the special needs of travelers with limited mobility or severe allergies. If you have concerns or health issues, please discuss with Peter's Way Tours before enrolling in the pilgrimage.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours (PWT) reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The \$500.00 deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2024, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from New York. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$3,545.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$150 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the groups' arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact PWT for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of **\$895 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. MEALS: Breakfast daily plus eight (8) dinners, including a festive dinner at St. Peter Stiftskulinarium with its famous Mozart Dinner Concert.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and €1.50 Euro per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
