DAY 1 Monday, April 13: Depart USA

Depart JFK International Airport on our overseas journey to Geneva, Switzerland. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served in flight.

DAY 2 Tuesday, April 14: Arrive in Geneva | Annecy | Lyon

Arrive at Geneva International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tour Manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable motor coach and we will be on our way to the village of Annecy (1-hour drive) magnificently situated on what is known as the *Blue Lake* in the heart of the Savoy Alps. Here, St. Francis de Sales and St. Jane Frances de Chantal founded the Congregation of the Visitation at Annecy in 1610. Relics of these saints are in the Basilica of the Visitation at Annecy. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Visitation.** Independent lunch and free time before continuing to Lyon (2-hour drive). Upon arrival in Lyon, we will check in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lyon.

DAY 3 Wednesday, April 15: Lyon | Ars | Paray Le Monial

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will visit Fourvière Hill, where in the 12th century a chapel was dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary and became an important pilgrimage site. Many believe that the powerful intercession of the Virgin Mary saved the town from a plague in the seventeenth century. The place was a source of inspiration and conversion for many saints. In the 19th century, St. Peter Julian Eymard (1811-1868), the "Apostle of the Eucharist," prayed at the shrine and responded to the call to form the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament. After our visit to the Basilica of Notre-Dame de Fourvière, we will leave Lyon for Ars to visit the Shrine of St. John Vianney, the patron saint of priests (1-hour drive). Visit the 12th century church where St. John Vianney preached. **Celebrate Mass in the Basilica of Ars** and pray near the preserved body of the saint in a glass reliquary. Time will be given to visit the home of the Curé of Ars, which contains the saint's bed, rosary, breviary, library, and other personal items. Independent lunch in Ars.

Continue to Paray-le Monial, where Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the Visitation Convent (1.5-hour drive). From here, devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus spread throughout the world. Visit the great medieval church, built as the official basilica to commemorate the apparition. Time will be given for prayer and reflection at the Shrine in Paray-Le-Monial. After our visit, check-in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paray-Le-Monial. (B,D)

DAY 4 Thursday, April 16: Nevers | Chartres

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will travel to Nevers (2-hour drive), where we will visit Saint Gildard Convent and **celebrate Mass at St. Bernadette's Shrine.** We'll have the opportunity to pray before St. Bernadette's incorrupt body. Independent lunch in Nevers. After lunch, continue to Chartres (3-hour drive). The cathedral spires of Chartres can be seen from miles away, seeming to rise out of the wheat fields of the Beauce Plains. In Chartres, we will visit Notre Dame Cathedral, which boasts an unrivaled expanse of sculpture as well as one of Europe's most impressive collections of stained-glass windows. The cathedral houses the Sancta Camisia, a tunic that tradition says belonged to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Check-in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Chartres. (B,D

DAY 5 Friday, April 17: Alençon | Lisieux

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, drive to Alençon (2-hour drive). Upon arrival in Alençon, we will visit the Martin family home and birthplace of St. Thérèse. Thérèse was born in Alençon on January 2, 1873, to Saints Louis Martin and Azélie-Marie Guérin. When Thérèse was only four, her mother died, and her father moved the family to Lisieux, where the five children were watched by their aunt. An older sister, Mary, ran the household and the eldest, Pauline, made herself responsible for the religious upbringing of her sisters. Continue to Lisieux (1-hour drive) with a stop for independent lunch. Upon arrival in Lisieux we will visit the Basilica of St. Thérèse. **Celebrate Mass in the Crypt Chapel.** Then, visit "Les Buissonnets," the family home where St. Thérèse spent her childhood. Continue to the Carmelite convent where she remained cloistered until her death. We will have time for prayer by her relics at the shrine. Check in to our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lisieux. (B,D)

DAY 6 Saturday, April 18: D-Day Landing Beaches

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will **celebrate Mass at the Cathedral of St. Peter**, where the Martin family went regularly to Mass. After Mass we will leave Lisieux to visit the Normandy Beaches and sites of the D-Day Landings (1-hour drive). Independent lunch.

On June 6, 1944, tens of thousands of American, English, Canadian, Scottish, and French soldiers landed on the beaches of the Normandy coast to free France from the Nazi stronghold. Thousands of young soldiers died that first day in the name of liberty. The coast of Normandy still has the indelible scars of that event. We'll explore Omaha Beach, the most famous of the Normandy landing beaches, and Pointe du Hoc, a high point between Utah and Omaha Beaches, renowned for the daring assault conducted on June 6, 1944, by the 2nd U.S. Ranger Battalion to neutralize the German artillery battery there. Finally, we'll visit the Normandy American Cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer, where these young soldiers are buried. (Arrive in time for the flag lowering). Time will be given for prayer and reflection. Return to Lisieux. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lisieux. (B,D)

DAY 7 Sunday, April 19: Rouen | Paris

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll check out of our hotel and leave for Rouen (1-hour drive), the port city at the mouth of the Seine River on the English Channel. Rouen is filled with lovely churches, old half-timbered houses, and poignant reminders of Joan of Arc, who was burned alive here on May 30, 1431. Visit Rouen Cathedral, an imposing sample of Gothic architecture built in 396 by Bishop Victricius. The cathedral was destroyed by the invading Normans, who replaced it with a larger cathedral with a wooden vault. Consecrated in 1063 in the presence of William the Conqueror, all that remains of this building is the crypt beneath the choir. Notre Dame in Rouen was often chosen by the French Impressionist painter, Monet, as the facade building in many of his paintings. Rouen Cathedral boasts a strong musical tradition since the Middle Ages. Its choir was famous up to the French Revolution for singing from memory. Celebrate Mass at Rouen Cathedral. Continue to St. Joan of Arc Church in Rouen (10-minute walk). A dazzling modern church and memorial dedicated to St. Joan of Arc, France's patron saint, can be visited in the centuries-old marketplace. Independent lunch in Rouen. Continue to Paris for hotel check-in (2.5-hour drive).

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris.

DAY 8 Monday, April 20: Pilgrimage Sites of Paris

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we will visit the Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal. The Chapel on Rue de Bac is a place of peace and silence in the heart of Paris. Learn about the life of St. Catherine Labouré, to whom the Virgin Mary appeared, and leave with a medal that the Daughters of Charity still share with those that they meet. Pilgrims can pray in the same place where the apparitions occurred and in front of the Saint's reliquary. **Celebrate Mass at the shrine.** Then, continue to the Shrine of St. Vincent de Paul, a few blocks away. We will pray near the relics of St. Vincent, the Apostle of Charity. Independent lunch.

This afternoon we will explore Montmartre and visit Sacré-Cœur Basilica. In 1870, war broke out between France and Germany, and France was invaded. Some Parisians believed that the war came to France because of its spiritual faults, rather than only political ones. This gave birth to the construction of a basilica dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This project was seen as atonement and as a force of hope and spiritual renewal. Parisian and French Christians pledge to maintain there a permanent 24/7 prayer in exchange for the protection of Paris. In 1872, the archbishop of Paris approved the project and chose the hill of Montmartre for the site. Dinner at a restaurant in Montmartre.

Overnight at our hotel in Paris.

DAY 9 <u>Tuesday, April 21: Sainte Chapelle | Notre Dame | Seine River Cruise</u>

Breakfast at our hotel. Our day begins with a visit to lle de la Cité and Sainte Chapelle, a masterpiece of stunning Gothic architecture built by Saint Louis in the heart of the Palais de la Cité. Discover its unique stained-glass windows, which render the air iridescent with light and color of the symbols of Heavenly Jerusalem. Continue to the Cathedral of Notre-Dame de Paris to participate in the noon Angelus and Mass (Fr. Tom will concelebrate). After Mass, explore this magnificently restored cathedral with its massive flying buttresses, famous towers, and elegant rose windows that will take your breath away. After our visit, enjoy a panoramic tour by coach to see the remarkable sights of Paris, including the Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysées, Arc de Triômphe, Tomb of Napoleon, Place de la Concorde, Opéra Bastille, Bastille Square, and the Place des Vosges, the oldest square in Paris and one of the most beautiful squares in the world. Independent lunch. Enjoy free time this afternoon to explore the sights, sounds and tastes of Paris all on your own! This would be a good time to visit the Louvre Museum, climb the Eiffel Tower, stroll the Jardins du Luxembourg, or go shopping in the Faubourg Saint-Honoree district.

Early evening, board the famous Parisian "bateaux-mouches" for a dinner cruise on the Seine. Dine in classic French style and enjoy the magical spectacle of the Seine River and the illuminated monuments that run along its banks as night begins to fall.

Overnight at our hotel in Paris.

DAY 10 Wednesday, April 22: Return to the USA

After breakfast, we will be transferred to Paris CDG Airport for our return flight to the USA. (B)

This pilgrimage entails a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc.
Participants must be medically and physically fit for this type of travel.
Package inclusions do not always meet the special needs of travelers with limited mobility or severe allergies. If you have concerns or health issues, please discuss with Peter's Way Tours before enrolling in the pilgrimage.
