**PARISH VISION STATEMENT**

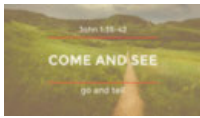

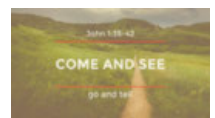

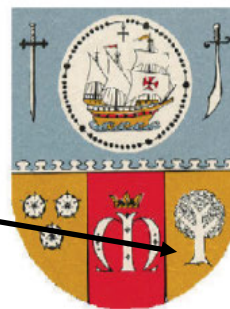
**Bellerose Village Centennial**

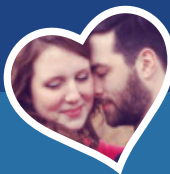
