#### Sunday, January 21 Word of God Sunday



Pope Francis has invited us to concentrate on the treasure of Sacred Scripture during this Third Sunday of Ordinary Time.

As I've mentioned before, there's a very worthwhile podcast that I can recommend: The Bible in a Year—with Fr. Mike Schmitz. You listen for 20 minutes a day, and your connection to the Word of God will be strengthened in life-changing ways!

#### Monday, January 22 Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

We must continue to pray for the conversion of the minds, hearts and souls of men and women who choose death over life. Here in New York State we must continue to be vigilant against legislative actions that promote a culture of death over a culture of life.

#### Tuesday, January 23 Feast of St. Vincent, Deacon

This feast day has been transferred to Jan. 23rd. Since St. Vincent was a Deacon, it is a good opportunity to be grateful for all the deacons in the church, including our own Deacon Larry Mulligan. Let us also pray for an increase in vocations to the diaconate.

#### Wednesday, January 24 Feast of St. Francis de Sales

St. Francis de Sales was a Bishop and Doctor of the Church. The Salesians, and other religious communities were founded based on his spirituality.

# Thursday, January 25 Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul

Today, reflect on the familiar story of the conversion of St. Paul. Today, take the time to read the New Testament letters to St. Timothy and St. Titus. They would be a total of 13 chapters - and they offer tremendous advice. Start with the three chapters of the Letter to Titus.




