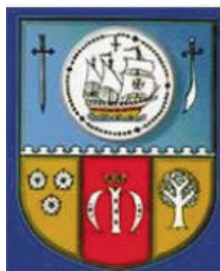
First let me talk about the value of Catholic Education in general, and then the value of Catholic Education here at Our Lady of Victory in particular.



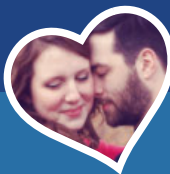
