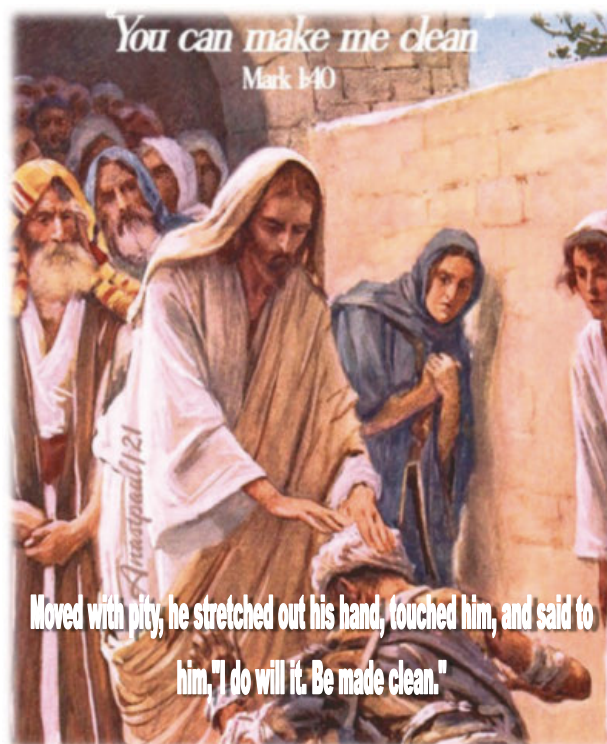

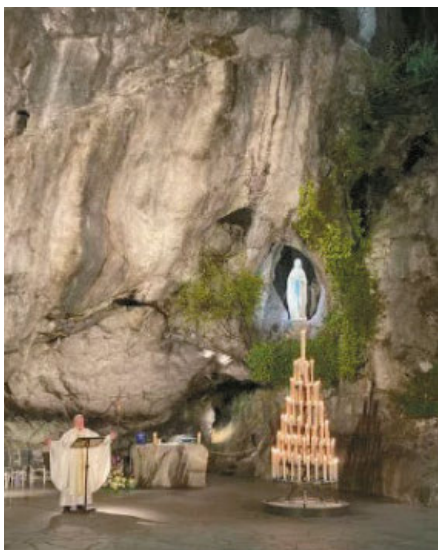

Ash Wednesday - Feb. 14th

This year Ash Wednesday and Valentines Day coincide. Ash Wednesday takes precedence! May I suggest you celebrate Valentines Day on another day.

On Wednesday, even though it is Valentines Day, the rules of fast and abstinence apply:

All Catholics who have reached their fourteenth year are bound to abstain entirely from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

All Catholics between the ages of eighteen and fifty-nine inclusive are also bound to observe the law of fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Distribution of Ashes

Ministers of Holy Communion have volunteered to be available on Ash Wednesday to be distributors of blessed ashes. Ashes will be available throughout the day, beginning with a Liturgy of the Word at 7:00 am and continuing until 9:00 pm.

Masses will be celebrated at 8:30 am, 9:30 am with the children from OLV School, 12 noon and 7:00 pm.

Lenten Prayer

On the Mondays of Lent we will have a Holy Hour from 7 pm to 8 pm each week. There will be Adoration, the Rosary, music, confessions and Benediction.

On the Friday of Lent we will have the Stations of the Cross at 11:30 am and at 7:00 pm each week in the church. That is in addition to our usual Eucharistic Adoration from 1 pm to 5 pm in the Parish Center chapel. No evening holy hour in Lent.

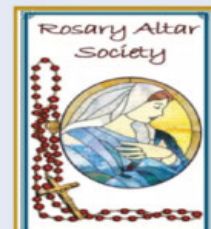

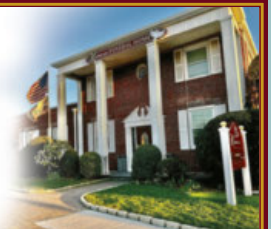
