

Dear Parishioners,

Thanks be to God, the pilgrimage to Rome and Assisi was safe, spiritual, and enjoyable for all 28 pilgrims! Together we fulfilled the goal of the pilgrimage by praying at the tombs of both St. Peter and St. Paul. We also visited all the Major Basilicas, as well as the Church of Our Lady of Victory - all while enjoying great food, good wine, and a gelato or two! Our day trip to Assisi was spiritually enriching as we visited the churches where St. Francis, St. Clare, and Blessed Carlo Acutis are buried. The weather was mild all week – and other than being put on stand-by for our flight home because of a strike by the workers at Lufthansa – everything went smoothly! Even the strike worked out fine for us because we all made a non-stop flight home.



I want to thank everyone who was on the pilgrimage – especially our tour guide, Elisabeth, whose extensive knowledge of Roman and church history was matched only by her engaging

personality! I also want to thank everyone at Peter's Way for making the trip successful! And special thanks to Fr. Daniel for handling everything at the parish while I was away!

Consider joining us for the next trip which will be in November to Prague, Vienna, Salzburg and Munich. Elisabeth will be our tour guide again, so I know it will be a great trip! Information can be found on our parish website.

This week at OLV

We have set aside this Lenten week to provide a spiritual activity each night for a Lenten "mission" week — albeit done differently than usual. This year we will provide opportunities for us to listen to God in the quiet of our prayer, to listen to a presenter, and to listen to one another. Let me explain further.

I have become more and more convinced that there is as much wisdom to be found "around the table" as there is "behind the podium."
What I mean is that I think we are accustomed to having someone speak to us – but I also think

it's good for us to speak to each other. So this year we are combining the two approaches. Fr. Patrick Flanagan from St. John's University will speak to us on Wednesday evening, and we will speak to each other on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. Let me explain the plan for each night of the week further:

Monday & Friday - Come and listen to God!

On Monday, we will take to the time to listen quietly to God in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament during a Holy Hour from 7 pm to 8 pm. It will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament followed by the praying of the Rosary, and then meditative music until we conclude with Benediction at 8 pm. The opportunity for confession will be available during the hour.

On Friday, the Stations of the Cross will be prayed in the church at 11:30 am and 7:00 pm. Eucharistic Adoration will take place in the Parish Center Chapel from 1 pm to Benediction at 5 pm.

Tuesday and Thurs. – Listen to one another!

At 7:30 pm on Tuesday and Thursday evenings Fr. Daniel and I would like to invite you to a discussion on the book, <u>Beautiful</u> <u>Eucharist</u>, which was made available to you last weekend. Let me explain the format for the evenings. On Tuesday night I will begin with sharing one of the chapters from the book, and then sharing my own experience of the power of the Eucharist. Then I will invite the six people at each table to share with one another which chapter of the book had the greatest impact on them and why. We'll then conclude by talking about how the discussions went. Fr. Daniel will follow a similar format on Thursday night.

Wednesday - Listen to a speaker!

We are happy to welcome Fr. Patrick Flanagan, CM, the chairperson of the Department of Theology and Religious Studies at St. John's University, to offer a presentation entitled, "*Refueling @ Halftime*." This presentation will take place in the church at 7:30 pm in the context of Evening Prayer.

Please join us for any or all these Lenten practices!






