



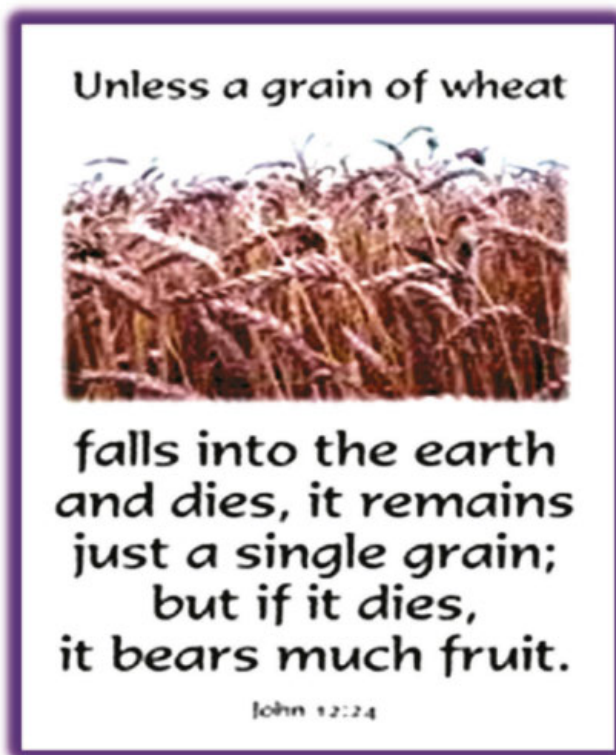

### ***Dear Parishioners,***

The liturgical calendar has a plan that is the purview of liturgists - and not always understood or appreciated by the rest of us. It has to do with the liturgical season and the rank of the feast day. So for those who might be interested, let me tell you about some of the anomalies with the feasts of St. Patrick, St. Joseph, and the Annunciation this year:

### ***St. Patrick's Day***



The Fifth Sunday of Lent takes priority over the optional memorial of St. Patrick, and so that's why his feast is not being celebrated liturgically this weekend. But it can certainly still be celebrated culturally! So, Happy St. Patrick's Day - and let's honor the great evangelizer of Ireland in a dignified way with parades,

corned beef and cabbage, soda bread and scones and good Irish music!

### ***St. Joseph's Day***

St. Joseph's Feast Day is a Solemnity, and therefore it takes priority over the Lenten weekday and does get celebrated with the Mass of St. Joseph on this Tuesday, March 19th. Let's pray that the spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the patron of the universal church will continue to protect the Church universally and locally!



### ***Feast of the Annunciation***



The Feast of the Annunciation, which is usually celebrated nine months before Christmas, on March 25th is the highest rank of feast day, called a Solemnity. However this year March 25th is during Holy Week, and the days of Holy Week take priority even over Solemnities. But, the Feast is too important to skip - so it gets moved to the next available day that is not a Solemnity, which is the Monday after the Second Sunday of Easter - April 8th this year. So we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation, just not on its usual day!.

I suspect this is way too much information for most of you - but for those of us who celebrate Mass daily, it explains this year's liturgical celebrations of these important Catholic feast days!

### **Palm Sunday - next weekend**

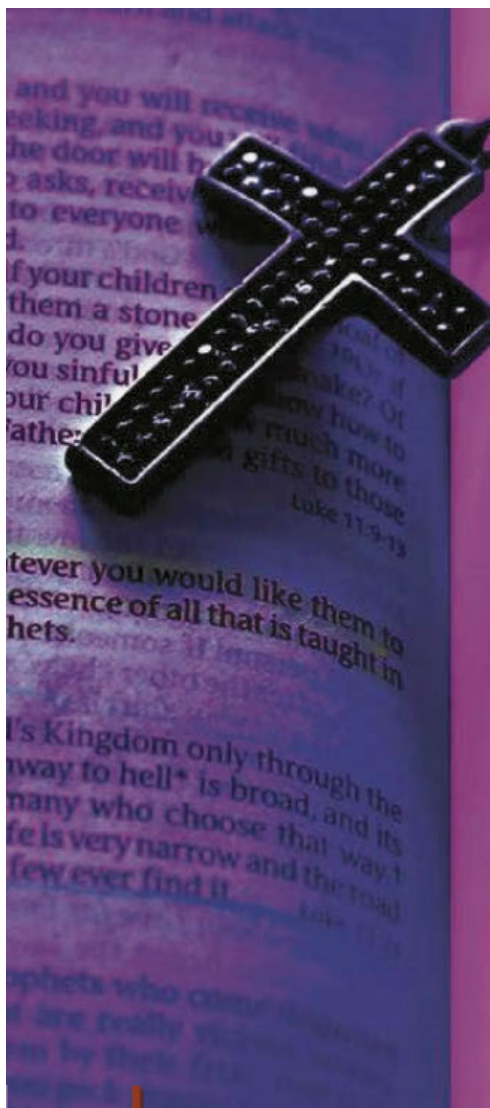

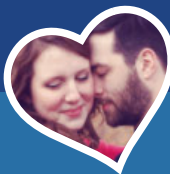
