We are beginning the holiest week of the year. It provides us with the opportunity to experience liturgy in ways that are unique to this sacred time. I can't encourage you enough to take the time to gather with us in church this week to deepen your relationship to the Lord.

Palm Sunday

Palms will be blessed and distributed at all the Masses this weekend. We will follow our usual schedule:

Saturday 4:00 pm & 5:30 pm

Sunday 7:30, 9:00, 10:30, 12 noon & 5:30 pm

All the Palm Sunday Masses will be broadcast to the chapel and live-streamed.

Reconciliation Monday

Churches in New York City, Brooklyn, Queens and Long Island, including Our Lady of Victory, will have priests available for Confession on Monday, March 25th between 2 pm and 4 pm and between 6 pm and 9 pm.

Confessions will also be heard this week on Holy Saturday between 11 am and 12:30 pm and between 2 and 3:30 pm.

Morning Prayers

Morning Prayer will be prayed in the church at 8:30 am on Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

Holy Thursday

The Mass of the Lord's Supper will be celebrated at 7:30 pm on Thursday. Two unique features of this Mass are the Washing of Feet and the Procession of the Eucharist. Please let us know at the rectory if you would like to be a participant of the feet washing ritual. The procession with the Blessed Sacrament will take place at the end of the Mass as we bring the Blessed Sacrament to the lower church where it will be available for Adoration until 12 midnight.

Good Friday

The Stations of the Cross will be prayed at 12 noon and at 7:30 pm in the Church. There will also be a Stations of the Cross for children in Memorial Park at 1:30 pm.

The Liturgy of the Lord's Passion will take place at 3 pm and will be broadcast to the lower church. The Liturgy includes the Veneration of the Cross and the distribution of Holy Communion.

Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence.

Holy Saturday

The Easter Vigil is the only Mass on Holy Saturday. It begins at 7:30 pm with the Service of Light and continues with seven readings from Scripture, the blessing of the Easter water and the liturgy of the Eucharist.

Palm Sunday

As we begin the Triduum, a Latin word that means “three days”, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday (The Easter Vigil) our rituals, celebrations and prayer times take on a special significance. We also rely on strong symbolism and deeply meaningful gestures to capture the fullness of what we remember and celebrate at this time of year.

As parents, we can offer an especially meaningful learning experience to our children during this time, by helping them take special notice of the many symbols and gestures we use. There is the silence and darkness and stripping of the altar after Mass on Holy Thursday; there is the Good Friday service, when children will notice that a good part of the Mass is “missing”, as well as a Stations of the Cross; there is the rejoicing at the Easter Vigil as we progress from darkness to light.

Together, let us draw our children's attention to these symbols and express the great mystery of the “three days”.

“Through the cross, You brought joy to the world.”

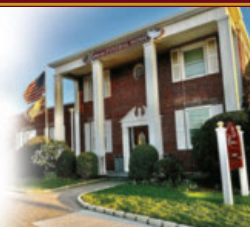
