

Dear Parishioners,



On Thursday of this week I am going to turn 65 years old! I'm passing that significant milestone where I created a Social Security account so I could sign up for Medicare. Now I listen more carefully to the medical advice, "if you're 65 years or older ..."

But here's why I'm mentioning it - in my 65 years we have had 6 Popes in the Church - John XXIII, Paul VI, John Paul I, John Paul II, Benedict XVI, and Francis. Of those six, three have been canonized already, one has been beatified, one is only recently deceased and the sixth is still alive. My point is that in my lifetime we have had Holy Popes - and given the fact that that has not always been the case in history, we should consider ourselves greatly blessed by the leadership of these holy men!

One of the themes that they have each preached has been the theme of Divine Mercy - with Pope St. John Paul II in particular being the Pope who instituted Divine Mercy Sunday to be celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter each year; and with

Pope Francis being the Pope who had a Year of Mercy in 2016 and who wrote "The Name of God is Mercy."

So this weekend let us acknowledge the grace of Divine Mercy - the awareness that God is always ready and willing to extend his Divine Mercy to each of us. Consider the beautiful image of Divine Mercy:

First, Christ's gaze. His eyes are looking upon us and they see our anxiety, our fears, our challenges, and our aloneness. And we look upon Him and we see His mercy, His care, His love for us. Be sure to take it in. Let Him gaze upon you.

Second, the rays that come from his wounded heart – the pale ray sending us the waters of baptism, the waters of rebirth, and the waters of forgiveness – of which we all have received. And the red ray of his Blood, poured out for us on the Cross and given to us in the Eucharist.

And then third, the prayer at the bottom of the image: those five powerful words: "Jesus I Trust in You." Words we need to say in times of uncertainty.

So, His gaze, His sacraments flowing from His Sacred Heart, and this prayer of trust are special gifts to us. They offer consolation. They provide peace. They provide mercy.

Please join us at 3 pm on this Sunday, April 7th to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy in the church.

DID YOU KNOW?

In November we will be voting on an amendment to be added to the NYS Constitution know as the Equality Amendment. NYS already has an Equal Rights Amendment which prohibits discrimination based on race, color, creed or religion. What this new amendment does is add additional categories like age, gender identity, gender expression and reproductive healthcare and autonomy. Sounds ok...or is it?

Over the next weeks we will be taking a deeper dive into this proposed amendment. It is important to understand the real life and legal ramifications of this poorly written and one size fits all amendment. Some are even now beginning to dub this new amendment: The Parent Replacement Act...but more on that next week.
