

MORE ON THE EQUALITY AMENDMENT . . .

Most people would agree that protecting human persons from any kind of discrimination is a just and right cause. However, this amendment does more than that. By adding in the clause "reproductive healthcare and autonomy", the sponsors of this amendment seek to enshrine unrestricted abortion rights in the NYS Constitution.

This is a move to ensure that NYS will be the abortion capital of the US, a goal also pursued by California. This amendment is totally gratuitous as the Reproductive Health Act of 2019 already has made unrestricted abortions legal in NYS (unrestricted meaning up until birth!) 


