Let me begin by giving a brief report on the pilgrimage/tour that 34 of us took to Prague, Vienna, Salzburg and Bavaria. All went well and everyone seemed to have an enjoyable time. Special thanks to Kathy Petronis for organizing the trip and to Peter's Way Tours for their professional job!

I will hit upon the highlights for me of each part of the trip.

In Prague I celebrated Mass at the Church of Our Lady Victorious, in the presence of the statue of the Infant of Prague. I can now add that statue to my collection!

In Vienna we enjoyed a live performance of Mozart's music while enjoying dinner in a luxurious dining hall.

In Salzburg we stopped at various locations associated with the Sound of Music - including celebrating Mass at the magnificent church where the wedding scene was filmed.

In Bavaria there were two highlights, each very different. We had the profound experience of visiting the Dachau concentration camp and celebrating Mass at the convent of the Carmelite sisters who are now there. And on the other end of the spectrum I enjoyed a festive Bavarian Christmas Market.

I am grateful to everyone who made this enjoyable experience so memorable!

The Advent Wreath



One of the time honored traditions for Catholics is the Advent Wreath. The custom of using candles in Advent dates back to the 16th century.

Today, the beauty of the wreath is a reminder of the richness our Church has to offer with signs and symbols. The circle of the wreath symbolizes God, who has no beginning and no end; nor does His love for us. Evergreens are often used in the Advent wreath—green is the symbol of hope. The evergreen, even though it dies, stays true to its color, just as Christ died but is with us now. The purple candles are a reminder that Advent is a time of penance and preparation for the coming of Christ. The pink candle reminds us that through this toil of preparation what we are waiting for is truly wonderful.

Praying together as the family lights the Advent wreath is a good way to keep Advent at the forefront of our daily lives leading up to Christmas.

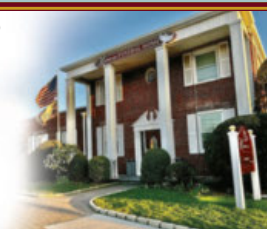
