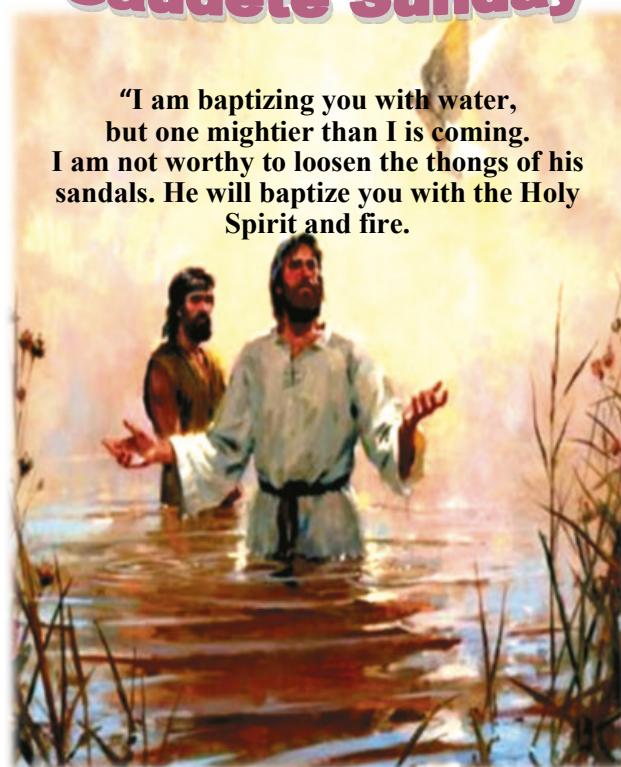

End of Bankruptcy Statement

"We are grateful to God that on December 4th, the court confirmed the Plan that resolves and ends the Bankruptcy Case for the Diocese of Rockville Centre and all our parishes. As you know, to compensate abuse survivors and resolve all parish lawsuits, the Diocese and every parish made a contribution to the settlement."

The OLV contribution to the settlement was \$986,313, all of which came from a single recent bequest to the parish.

"To further protect the parishes from any past liability, it was necessary for every parish to enter into an abbreviated Chapter 11. That process is also completed, and now our parishes can get on with the work of proclaiming Jesus Christ, free from the cloud of bankruptcy and historical lawsuits.

We pray for all survivors of child abuse, that by the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the compassion of others, they may find healing and comfort. We pray for our parishes and all ministries that serve God and the common good of all people on Long Island, that Mary, Mother of the Church will intercede for us. Out of this dark chapter in the Church's history, we look to a time of resurrection, to a Church purified and eager to bring the saving message of Jesus Christ to all people."

GUIDE TO CONFESSION

- 1 Prepare** - Prayerfully compare your life to the Ten Commandments, the Beatitudes and the example of Christ.
- 2 Go to confession** - After the priest welcomes you, both of you make the Sign of the Cross. Begin your Confession by saying,
"Forgive me Father for I have sinned. It has been [length of time] since my last Confession. These are my sins..."
- 3 Act of Penance** - The priest offers suitable advice and gives you an act of penance, which may include prayer, self-denial or works of mercy.
- 4 Prayer of the Penitent** - Pray a prayer, such as the **Act of Contrition**, expressing sorrow for your sins and a desire not to sin again.
- 5 Absolution** - The priest extends his hands over your head and prays the Prayer of Absolution, making the Sign of the Cross over your head during the final words. You respond, "Amen".
- 6 Dismissal** - The priest sends you forth to go in peace. Continue to express your conversion through a life renewed according to the Gospel and the love of God.

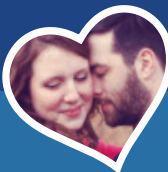

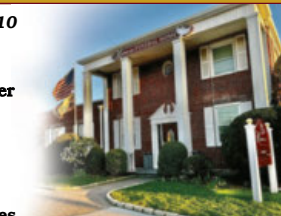
