Dear Parishioners,

When a feast of the Lord occurs on a Sunday in Ordinary Time, the feast day replaces the Ordinary Time Sunday. That's what is happening this weekend. Because the February 2nd Feast of the Presentation occurs on a Sunday this year, the 4th Sunday of Ordinary Time is replaced by the feast. In other words, the feast day takes priority over the Ordinary Sunday.

The opening greeting for the Mass explains what we are celebrating:

"Dear brothers and sisters,

Forty days have passed since we celebrated the joyful feast of the Nativity of the Lord. Today is the blessed day when Jesus was presented in the Temple by Mary and Joseph. Outwardly, he was fulfilling the Law, but in reality he was coming to meet his believing people.

Prompted by the Holy Spirit, Simeon and Anna came to the Temple. Enlightened by the same Spirit, they recognized the Lord and confessed him with exultation.

So let us also, gathered together by the Holy Spirit, proceed to the house of God to encounter Christ. There we shall find him and recognize him in the breaking of the bread, until he comes again, revealed in glory."

Part of the tradition associated with the Feast of the Presentation is that it is also referred to as Candlemas Day - with the blessing of candles. This tradition comes from the line in the Gospel that when Simeon calls the infant Jesus, "a light for revelation to the Gentiles."

Blessed candles will be available in the front of the church.

Also, let me suggest that you take time to look closely at the stained glass window on the left side in the back of the church - it beautifully depicts the story of the Presentation with Jesus, Mary, Joseph, Simeon and Anna.

Blessing of Throats

The traditional blessing of throats will take place after each of the daily Masses on Monday, February 3rd, the Feast of St. Blaise.

Also the children in OLV School and Faith Formation program will receive the individual blessing during their class times.

"Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God preserve you from all disease of the throat and from every other illness."



Jubilee Year of Hope

Next weekend in the Vatican, the Pope will be hosting Jubilee Year events for members of the armed forces, police, first responders and security personnel.

In conjunction with those events, there will be a blessing for all members of the armed forces, police, first responders and security personnel at all the Masses next weekend.

Some of my strongest memories of recent years are the celebrations our Village has held in Memorial Park recognizing Veterans and military personnel and first responders. Next weekend we acknowledge them again together with the whole Church!


