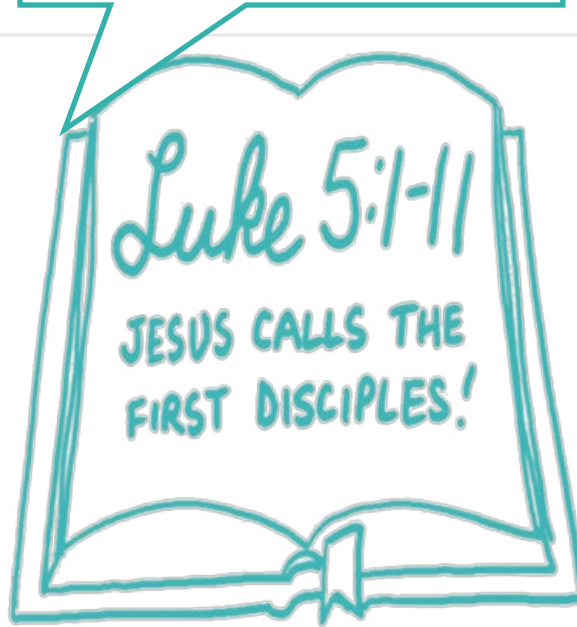

OLV Bereavement Support Group

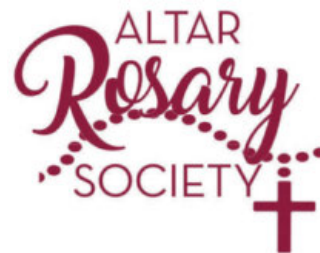
An eight week bereavement support group is meeting on Tuesday evenings from 7 pm to 8:30 pm, beginning on March 4th and will continue to meet until April 22th.

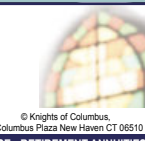
