

This is a copy of the email I just sent to State Senator Patricia Canzoneri-Fitzpatrick and Assemblywoman Michaelle Solages:

Although we appreciate the funding that you and Governor Hochul provide to religious and independent schools for STEM and Non-Public Safety Equipment (NPSE), we are very disappointed that the Governor proposed eliminating funds to reimburse our schools for their costs related to complying with the immunization mandate, as well as the funding you added last year for Academic Intervention and Support Services (AIS).

In finalizing the state budget, as it relates to independent and religious schools, I urge:

- Immunization funding sufficient to reimburse all these schools across the state for their compliance costs;
- A meaningful increase in AIS funding to enable our schools to support the academic needs of students; and
- Increased funding for STEM and NPSE.

Thank you in advance for supporting the Catholic school families in your district.




