This weekend the Jubilee Year celebrations in the Vatican will be centered on Deacons. We have been greatly blessed here at Our Lady of Victory with the ministry of Deacon Larry Mulligan for the past 31 years and counting!

Over the years Deacon Larry, together with his wife Andrea, has been involved in all aspects of parish life. His name appears more frequently than anyone else's in the parish Baptismal Register - having performed the sacrament of baptism for numerous babies over the years.

The role of the Deacon is a role of service to the Church - and Deacon Larry has certainly given service to our parish and diocese!

We are also blessed to have a Deaconcandidate from our parish. Will Doherty is currently going through the process of formation for the Diaconate. In April he will be taking the next step in his formation when he is installed as a Lector.

This is how the Ministry of Deacon is described on the diocesan website:

The deacon serves in the Ministry of the Word, the Ministry of Liturgy, and the Ministry of Charity and Justice.

The deacon is a sacred minister and a member of the clergy. He is ordained to serve God's people in communion with the bishop and priests. The deacon vows respect and obedience to the bishop.

Because the deacon is involved in the secular world to a greater extent than the priest, he has the ability to bring the Gospel message into the workplace.

Deacons, both married and unmarried, give witness to the Gospel value of sacrificial love and the dignity of human work. The deacon has the special opportunity and obligation to proclaim and witness the Gospel in his secular profession.

If you are a single, married or widowed man, under the age of 60, who is actively involved in the life of the parish and who feels a call to the Ministry of Deacon, please contact me or Deacon Larry at the rectory so we can discuss it together.






