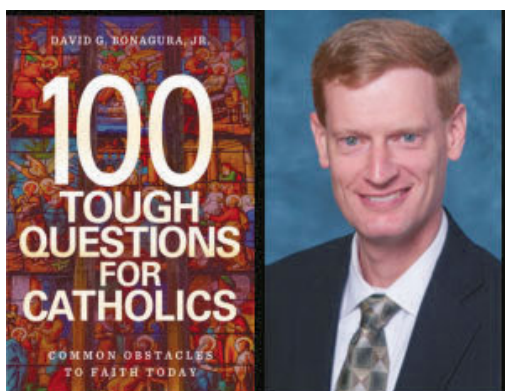


Congratulations to parishioner, **Doug Hayden**, for being honored as the CYO Volunteer of the year at the CYO of Long Island

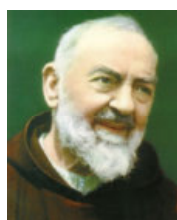
## Update on Assisted Suicide Medical Aid in Dying Act

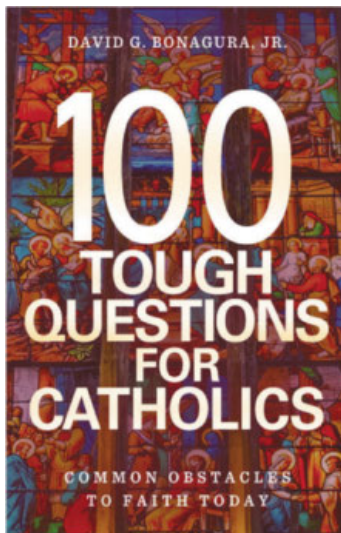
