





***Praise God for the gift of Pope Leo XIV!
We prayed for a Pope with humility, and
our prayer was heard and granted!***

*The following is taken from my homily of
this past weekend-Good Shepherd Sunday:*

*This week Pope Leo XIV was given the
task of being the Good Shepherd, who fol-
lowing the example of Peter, the first Pope,
must now **lead, protect and unite** the
Church – and I think his choice of name
speaks to his readiness and willingness to
fulfill three tasks of a Good Shepherd –
because there were three “Leos” in church
history who fit in with the three tasks.*

*The new Pope is called to **lead** 1.4 billion
Catholics in the right direction – which of
course is towards God and Heaven. His
name, Leo XIV, points us back to Pope Leo
XIII, the Pope at the end of the 19th
century, who is responsible for presenting*

*Catholic Social Teaching in his encyclical
Rerum Novarum – that’s the right direc-
tion for us today – the promotion of
Catholic Social Teaching. And as Pope Leo
XIII guided the Church through the
industrial revolution, Pope Leo XIV is
being asked to guide the Church through
the artificial intelligence revolution with
sound Catholic Social Teaching. He has
the human intelligence to lead us.*

*Secondly, a shepherd is asked to **protect**
the flock from the dangers of the world.
The first Pope to take the name Leo was
Pope St. Leo the Great from the 5th centu-
ry. He was the Pope who saved Rome from
the barbarian invasion – who protected the
Church from the false ideologies of the
Vandals and Huns. Today, our leader must
protect the flock from the false ideologies
of atheism and secularism and relativism
that lead to moral decline. There is much
the Church needs to be protected from as it
is attacked on numerous fronts. Pope Leo
has the strength to protect us.*

*Thirdly, the good shepherd **keeps the
flock together** by seeking out those who
stray. One of the closest companions of St.
Francis of Assisi was Brother Leo. As
Brother Leo was a close companion to St.
Francis; Pope Leo was a close companion
to Pope Francis. Both of them by the exam-
ples of their lives have sought out those
who were straying – Pope Francis by his
outreach to those on the margins of socie-
ty; and now Pope Leo by his missionary
life – serving as an American missionary in
Peru. His inclusive, global experience will
keep us united.*

Statement of Cardinal Dolan and the NYS Bishops on State-Sanctioned Suicide Bill

“Euthanasia and assisted suicide are a defeat for all. We are called never to abandon those who are suffering, never giving up but caring and loving to restore hope.” Pope Francis, 2019

On Easter Monday, April 21, Pope Francis ended his earthly journey and entered eternal life. The Holy Father gave us many examples to emulate throughout his life and ministry, even right to the end when he gave us an example of a holy, natural death.

Sadly, the very next day, news reports indicated that the New York State Assembly would take up legislation (A136/S138) to legalize state-sanctioned suicide for those who are diagnosed with a terminal illness. Euphemistically titled the Medical Aid in Dying Act, this bill would usher in a dangerous new era in our state, turning the Hippocratic Oath taken by physicians to “do no harm” on its head and leaving vulnerable individuals – people with disabilities, the elderly, and those in impoverished and medically underserved communities – subject to pressure and coercion to end their lives so as not to be a “burden” to society or an excessive cost to insurance companies.

One only need to look to the example of our neighbor to the north, Canada, to understand the risk. That country passed a similar law to New York’s bill in 2016. Within a few short years, it was expanded to allow not only those with terminal illnesses, but also those with “chronic” illnesses, such as arthritis, to end their lives. In 2027, the law is set to expand to those whose only underlying condition is mental illness, such as depression, anxiety or anorexia.


