

Dear Parishioners,

An important event for our Parish Eucharistic Revival will take place on this Wednesday, June 4th. Please participate.

The Blessed Sacrament that is on pilgrimage throughout the Diocese will be here at OLV beginning at 12:30 pm on Wednesday. The Blessed Sacrament will be brought into the school where each classroom will be blessed. Then the school children will form a Procession to church where the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed throughout the day.

Then there will be a Holy Hour from 7 pm to 8 pm with meditative and choir music. Father Chris Sullivan will offer a reflection during the Holy Hour.

Then at 8 pm we will have our Parish Eucharistic Procession bringing the Blessed Sacrament through the following streets: Bellmore St. to Carnation Ave. to Locust St. to Floral Parkway and back to the church.

Houses along the route will be blessed upon the request of the family - please call the rectory to obtain a lawn sign so we know which houses at which to stop.

Parishioners are invited to line the route of the Procession. While usually we would have a solemn procession, I hope this will be a festive one!

Next Sunday is Pentecost Sunday. Come ready to celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit!







Reminder from OLV Respect Life

"Often, the Catholic Church is unjustly accused of being more concerned with the baby in the womb than with the mother and child once the infant has been born. As false as this notion is, it is incumbent upon us as shepherds to acknowledge and address that misperception. As far back as the 1980s, the late John Cardinal O'Connor, a giant of the pro-life movement, made a pledge that we reaffirm today: Any woman - regardless of age, religious belief or affiliation, marital status or immigration status - who is pregnant and in need, can come to the Catholic Church and we will give you the services and supports you need to carry your baby to term, regardless of your ability to pay. Furthermore, we will not abandon you and your baby after delivery, but, rather, we will see to it that you have the resources that you and your child both need and deserve. No one will be turned away from life-affirming care. If you have had an abortion that you regret, whether recently or in the distant past, please come to us as well, so that we may offer you services to help you to heal."
