



**Dear Parishioners,**



On this Feast of Corpus Christi we are celebrating the great gift of the Body and Blood of Christ left to us in the Eucharist.

At our recent Eucharistic Revival processions in our school and in our parish we were graced with a powerful experience of the blessings that come through our devotion to the Eucharist.

This week there will be a Eucharistic Procession after the 12 noon Mass on Sunday, June 22nd. We will stop at the statues of the Blessed Mother on the rectory lawn and in the schoolyard for Benedictions, with the concluding Benediction taking place back in the church. Come and continue our devotion to the Eucharistic Lord!

I think our parish shows strong devotion in our worship, but I still like to use this Feast Day as an opportunity to remind all of us of the various ways we can show even greater reverence to the Blessed Sacrament throughout the year:

\* Genuflect when you come into church - which means the right knee goes all the way down and touches the floor. If you are physically unable to do that, then a profound bow, from the waist, is appropriate. The genuflection or profound bow is an action that we perform only in church - so it reminds us of where we are, and in whose Presence we are!

\* Please wear appropriate church attire for men and women — even in the summer months. Gentlemen remove hats and baseball caps.

\* Please try to be on time so as to prepare properly for Mass and so you are not a distraction to others when you arrive late. Also please remain in church until the conclusion of the closing hymn.

\*When everyone else is still, the person who is moving gets everyone's attention. So if you must move, please only do so when the congregation is changing its posture, so as to be less of a distraction.

\*In particular, from the time when the altar server rings the bells once (*the epiclesis*) to the end of the second triple ringing of the bells (*the consecration*) please maintain absolute silence and stillness (no movement) so as to focus on the consecration - and teach your children to do the same.

\* At the reception of Holy Communion, a head bow as you approach and an audible "Amen" in response are appropriate. Receiving in other ways, like on your knees or genuflecting right before receiving, are not more devout, in fact it lessens the spirit of unity that should be expressed by our common posture at the reception of Holy Communion.

\* Conversation is appropriate in the vestibule, silence is appropriate inside the church. This is out of respect for the parishioners who are in church seeking a quiet place to pray and offer thanksgiving.

All these practices show respect for the Body of Christ in the Eucharist and the Body of Christ in the Community. Thank you!


Although they would have attained their growth in spite of us, it has been our pleasure and privilege to watch their personalities unfold day by day and marvel at this splendid miracle of development.

## Stop Physician-Assisted Suicide in New York

**New York is on the brink of legalizing physician-assisted suicide.** Bill A136 has already passed the Senate and Assembly. **The only thing standing in its way is Governor Hochul's veto – and she needs to hear from you.**

This bill would allow doctors to prescribe lethal medication with the sole purpose of ending a patient's life. It puts the most vulnerable among us – the elderly, people with disabilities, and those facing emotional or financial despair – at even greater risk. **Suicide is not healthcare.**

**We must speak out to protect the dignity of every human life.** Assisted suicide is a dangerous and deadly path – one we must not go down.
