Ars - Basilica of Ars focusing on St. John Vianney, the Cure of Ars **Paray-le Monial** - Shrine of Paray-le

Monial focusing on St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Chartres Cathedral

Alencon & Lisieux - focusing on St. Therese the Little Flower and her parents, Sts. Louis & Zeile Martin Normandy Coast & Omaha Beach -D-Day landing sites

Rouen - focusing on St. Joan of Arc **Paris** - Shrine of the Miraculous Medal focusing on St. Catherine Laboure & St. Vincent de Paul. Visits to Sainte Chapelle & Notre Dame Cathedral. The cost for this 10 day trip is \$4700 per person.

Stop Physician-Assisted Suicide in New York

New York is on the brink of legalizing physician-assisted suicide. Bill A136 has already passed the Senate and Assembly. The only thing standing in its way is Governor Hochul's veto – and she needs to hear from you.

This bill would allow doctors to prescribe lethal medication with the sole purpose of ending a patient's life. It puts the most vulnerable among us - the elderly, people with disabilities, and those facing emotional or financial despair at even greater risk. Suicide is not healthcare.

We must speak out to protect the dignity of every human life. Assisted suicide is a dangerous and deadly path – one we must not go down.
