Dear Parishioners,

I hope you have been able to enjoy the more leisurely days of summer. I know I have. The rhythm of parish life changes. While there are more baptisms, weddings and funerals at this time of year, there are fewer meetings and school activities. So I thought I'd use my letter over the next few weeks to inform you about topics that comes up often here at the rectory regarding baptisms, marriages and funerals. I'll begin this week with the Sacrament of **Baptism** and specifically serving as a Godparent.

While most people use the terms godfather and godmother, the Church uses the term "sponsor." Only one sponsor is required at baptism. That one sponsor must meet the following requirements:

- 1) The sponsor must be a fully-initiated member of the Catholic Church who is at least 16 years old. This means that the sponsor must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion and Confirmation. Unbaptized people are not eligible to serve as sponsors.
- 2) The sponsor must participate in the life of the Church and provide good example of living out their faith.
- 3) If there are two sponsors, they are considered "spiritual parents" and therefore are to be a godfather and godmother. Two godfathers or two godmothers are not permitted.

The second sponsor can be a non-Catholic Christian, called a Christian witness. Unbaptized people are not eligible to serve as Christian witnesses.

Sponsors are required to sign a form testifying to their eligibility to serve as a sponsor by meeting the above requirements. These forms can be found on the parish website under the

"Sponsor Certificate" quicklink on our parish website homepage: <u>olvfpny.org</u>. I have also included a copy of the form on the back of this page.

If the sponsor is from a parish other than OLV, they need to have the form signed by a priest or deacon from the parish in which they are registered. That's another reason why it is important to register with your local parish, especially young people who might be asked to serve as a godparent or Confirmation sponsor some day.

Some parishes require a Confirmation certificate. Here at OLV the sponsor's signature saying they are eligible is enough.

These same requirements serve for the sponsor at the Sacrament of Confirmation. The requirements do not apply to the witnesses of marriage.

When deciding on who will serve as your child's godparents (*sponsor*) please consider the religious dimension of the role. At the baptism ceremony the sponsor-godparents will be asked to renew their baptismal promises and promise to help you in your role as Christian parents. Please be sure they are willing and eligible to do so before asking them!

Other Baptism notes here at OLV:

- Baptisms are held at 1:30 pm every Sunday to accommodate your schedules
- First time parents are asked to attend a preparation meeting prior to the baptism.
 The meetings are held on a Sunday every other month.
- There is no fee for baptisms. A free will offering may be made.

TESTIMONY OF DESIGNATED SPONSOR

The role of sponsor is an important one for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. Today some may see the role as honorary, but the Church sees the sponsor, popularly called a godparent, as a fully-initiated Catholic who actively supports the newly Baptized or Confirmed by good example and instruction in the Christian life.

In order to be admitted to the role of sponsor, the law of the Church directs that a person must be designated specifically by the parents of the infant or the individual who is to be baptized or confirmed. To be a sponsor, a person must be a Catholic, at least sixteen years of age, and have already received the Sacraments of the Most Holy Eucharist and Confirmation. In addition, he or she must be leading a life in harmony with the faith and not be bound by a canonical penalty.




