Dear Parishioners,

I mentioned in last week's letter that this week I would discuss some of the issues connected to weddings taking place in the church. A wedding celebration is a graced, sacramental moment - which means it's an opportunity to experience the presence of God in a direct and powerful way. That's why the Church takes it so seriously and why we ask members of the Church to do the same.

Roman Catholics who are free to marry are required to exchange their vows in the presence of a priest or deacon and two witnesses. In the Diocese of Rockville Centre this must take place in a church building. Here are the benefits of entering into marriage as a sacrament:

- * You are making a public statement of your intention to enter into a marriage that is lifelong, faithful, and open to children.
- * You can be assured of God's grace and presence in your marriage
- * You can continue to receive Holy Communion at Mass and to receive the other sacraments
- * You can serve as a godparent or Confirmation sponsor if asked

So what if you - or a family member choose to be married outside the church? I know this is the cause for much heartache for parents and grandparents. It's important to understand the reason for their decision. Here are some:

*if both parties are free to be married in the church (that means were not previously married), but they wanted a venue other than a church for their exchange of vows, they can still easily receive the sacrament of marriage in the church. It would be important for them to do this. It is called a convalidation — recognizing that they are already validly married in the eyes of the state, and wish to have their marriage validated in the Church. I have

even done convalidations at the same time as the baptism of their child.

*if they were married outside the church because one or both parties were previously married, then they could talk to a priest about what it would require for them to have the first marriage(s) declared null. Sometimes the process is simple, sometimes it is more extensive depending on the circumstances.

*if they were married outside the church because they do not have faith in God or do not want to be a part of the Church, then their family members have to respect their decision, while continuing to pray for their conversion of heart.

An interesting development in the celebration of weddings has been the exchange of vows in a simple ceremony, with just immediate family and friends present in the church, and then a larger reception happening at a later date. I have had positive experiences of these types of weddings because of their simplicity and focus on the essentials. I encourage the couple to let it be known at their later reception that they were married in the church prior to the celebration, so their family and friends know they entered into marriage as a sacrament.

My advice to parents and grandparents is to let your expectations be known to your children and grandchildren from the time they are teenagers - don't wait until they are engaged! Let them know that choosing to enter into marriage not as a sacrament is a serious rejection of their Catholic life.




Pass On the Gift of Faith!




