Mission Appeal

Next weekend is our Annual Mission Appeal. This year we are being asked to support the work of the Order of the Imitation of Christ. These missionaries work in India, Africa, the Philippines, Europe and the United States. Members of this community staff parishes in our Diocese. Our speaker will be Fr. Shibi Pappan, a member of this missionary community who is currently the pastor of St. Ignatius Parish in Hicksville.

Mass Intentions

It is a pious act to have Masses offered for deceased family members and friends. There are two ways to do this - announced Masses and unannounced Masses.

The announced Masses are the ones you see listed in the bulletin each week and are scheduled for a specific day and time. The name of the person for whom the priest is offering the Mass is announced during the prayer of the faithful. This is best used when family members and friends will be present at the Mass since hearing their loved one's name brings them consolation. Here at OLV, the book for announced Masses gets filled up quickly.

An unannounced Mass is when the priest offers the Mass for an individual on an unspecified day and time - when he has a Mass without an announced intention.

Obviously, the fruits of the Mass are the same whether the intention is announced or unannounced. The stipend for either is \$20.

When Monsignor McNamara is back in Rome he has the opportunity to celebrate unannounced Masses often. If you would like a Mass celebrated by him in the Eternal City, just request that when you come to the rectory office to arrange a Mass.

Some notes on Funerals:

Two weeks ago I wrote about baptisms, last week I wrote about weddings, this week the topic is funerals:

- 1) Let me encourage you to make your wishes known to your family regarding having a Funeral Mass. Regrettably, some families are not burying their devout family members with a Mass because they are not practicing themselves. If you think there's a chance that your family would do that - let them know now your wishes!
- 2) Cremations are happening with much greater frequency in recent years. The Church has no objection to cremation, as long as it isn't a statement against our belief in the resurrection of the body.

Some cremation issues to be aware of:

i) The preference is for the body to be present at the funeral Mass and the cremation to take place after the Mass. However, it is permissible for the cremation to take place first. In that case, the cremated remains can then be present in the church for the funeral Mass. The remains are treated with the same respect given to the body of the deceased person.

ii) The urn with the cremated remains should be interred as soon as possible after the funeral Mass. Please **do not** delay the burial by keeping the urn at home.

iii) The cremated remains (*ashes*) should not be divided up or scattered.

I heard from Fr. Daniel in Ghana and he reported that all went well for his father's funeral Mass.

Fortunately, Msgr. McNamara will be able to remain with us here at OLV longer than originally expected, before returning to Rome.

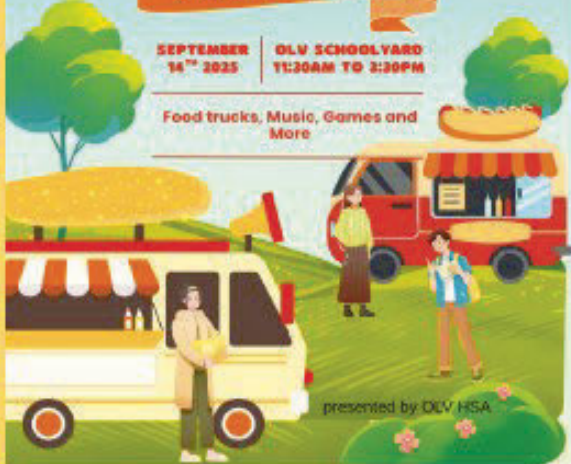

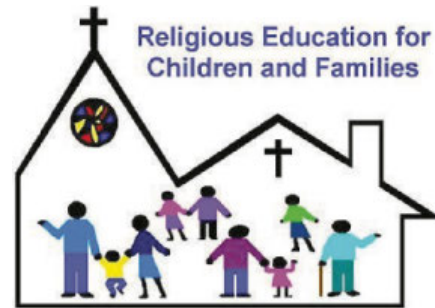

The Office for the Protection of Children and Young People (OFPCYP) has streamlined the volunteer application process enabling volunteers to complete the three safe environment requirements in one step. Individuals wishing to volunteer in a parish or school:

1. Register to attend a Protecting God's Children class and create a Virtus account on the Virtus website:
www.Virtus.org
2. Electronically acknowledge the Diocesan Code of Conduct- provided during the Virtus registration process.
3. Follow the instructions to complete the Sterling Volunteers background screening application background offered during the Virtus registration process.

Active Volunteers:

If you are active in a parish ministry, have already attended Virtus and have been background screened you may be at – or beyond- the *5yr. rescreening requirement*. If this is the case, you will receive an email from *Sterling Volunteers* asking you to complete the background screening application on-line. You may access the background screening application by following the prompt in the email or logging into your Virtus account. ***Please be aware-this is not a scam nor has your e-mail been hacked.*** The OFPCYP has been working with your parish to update the Safe Environment records and noted it is time for you to be rescreened. You may also be prompted to electronically resign the Code of Conduct when you log into your Virtus account.

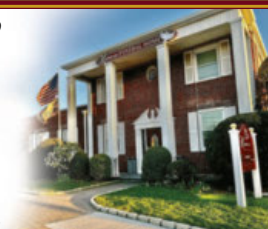
