



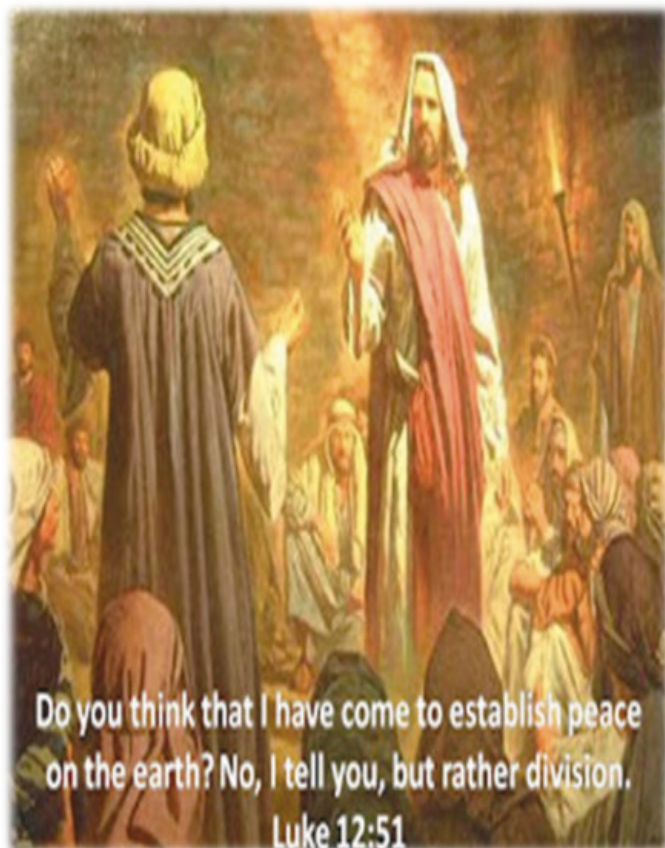

Dear College Students –

This is my annual letter to you as you begin the fall semester. My goal is to encourage you to continue to be good Catholic young people who maintain the values and virtues of your family. **May your values shape your college experience rather than having your college experience shape your values!**

I am finding that these letters get harder to write each year because the older I get the more removed I feel from college life. I'm not sure I have a good understanding of life on college campuses these days. I just have lots of questions.

*** Are colleges as radical as I hear?** I get the impression from the media that many college professors promote their own radical agendas instead of teaching the truth and that college campuses are hotbeds of extremism. **If so, avoid the radicals!**

*** Are students afraid to express their opinions?** It seems that sometimes students feel (or know) that your grades will be negatively affected by expressing views that conflict with your professors' views. So you give the answers you are expected to give instead of expressing your own opinions. That's a lot of thought-control! **You may have to say it – but I hope you know you don't have to believe it!**

*** Are some Catholic schools Catholic in name only?** Even if a college or university has a Catholic name and is affiliated with a Catholic religious order, the Catholic identity of the school can be questionable. Catholic traditions and teachings are not always taught consistently. It amazes me how many students lose their faith after attending a Catholic college. **Your grandmother probably knows more about genuine faith than most of your professors – trust her and follow her example!**

*** Is it difficult for virtuous students to maintain their chastity in a college environment?** The early 20's are difficult enough years to manage, you certainly don't need negative influences around you. Surround yourself with other students who have similar goals and expectations for themselves regarding chastity. And maybe alcohol contributes to some of these bad decisions. **Respect yourself and one another!**

*** Are college students suffering the effects of isolation brought about by modern technology?** There are people your own age all around you, go out and socialize – but choose wisely. **It's not about fitting in, it's about finding others who fit in with you!** Always be conscious of the many dangers of social media.

*** Is Artificial Intelligence making college easier or harder?** There is so much potential for the growth and development of the future through AI. May ethical and moral guidelines frame the progress that you are making in this area. **Bring your humanity to AI!**

*** On a positive note, is it also true that Catholic Campus Ministries are becoming stronger, particularly on secular college campuses, through groups like FOCUS?** These ministries provide an environment where young people can support one another in pursuing faith and in pursuing virtue. **Be a part of your campus ministry and go to Mass!**

*** Also on a positive note, are more and more college students getting involved in significant service projects and activities?** Spring breaks are becoming time for service trips to serve disadvantaged people in our own country and around the world. College students have so much talent and energy – this is the time for you to develop your skills and gain experience of service to others – especially as an expression of your Catholic faith and call to follow Catholic Social Teaching. **Go on a service trip!**

So as you can see I have a lot of questions about college life today. But what I know for sure is that when I look at college students today I am filled with hope for the future. As a group, you are enthusiastic, strong, creative, intelligent, thoughtful and compassionate!

Enjoy your college days by living them as **virtuous warriors!** Sometimes the fight might be difficult, but I am confident the Good, the True and the Beautiful will always prevail!

Make good choices – but if you get into trouble and need some help – just ask me!

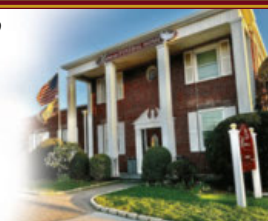
