



Dear Parishioners,

I am writing this letter prior to leaving with Msgr. McNamara to go to Rome. He will be there for the school year, and I'll be there for a week.

The highlight of the trip for me will be to attend the Canonization Mass of two new Saints - Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901-1925) and Carlo Acutis (1991-2006). These two young men are being presented to the Church as models of holiness among teenagers and young adults. Hopefully you will be hearing their stories of holiness from various sources this week. What I thought I would do would be to share with you the miracles attributed to these two young men that led them to be listed among the Saints. I take these accounts from All Saints Press 2025.

The Two Miracles of Pier Giorgio Frassati




The first miracle involved the healing of Domenico Sellan who was suffering from a grave case of tuberculosis in his spine which had left him paralyzed. In 1933 a priest brought him a prayer card of Frassati and Sellan, praying

with faith, was miraculously cured. He lived another 35 years in perfect health. This healing was officially recognized by the Church in 1989, paving the way for Frassati's beatification in 1990.

The second miracle, confirmed by Pope Francis on November 25, 2024, involved Father Juan Gutierrez, a seminarian in Los Angeles in 2017. Gutierrez tore his Achilles tendon during a basketball game., facing a painful recovery. Inspired to pray a novena to Frassati, he felt a warm sensation in his ankle during prayer. Days later, an orthopedic surgeon found no trace of the injury,

despite prior MRI evidence. The healing was verified through a diocesan inquiry and Vatican examination, deemed inexplicable by medical experts.

The Two Miracles of Carlo Acutis



The first miracle, recognized for Acutis' beatification involved the healing of Matheus Vianna, a Brazilian boy born with a rare pancreatic disorder that caused severe vomiting and malnourishment. During a prayer service where a relic of

Acutis was present, Matheus' mother prayed for intercession while Matheus himself touched the relic and expressed his desire to stop vomiting. From that moment on he no longer experiences symptoms, with his pancreas healing completely, a recovery doctors deemed inexplicable.. The Vatican verified this miracle in February 2020.

The second miracle, recognized by Pope Francis in May 2024, involved a young Costa Rican woman named Valeria Valverde. Valeria suffered a severe brain hemorrhage from a bicycle accident in Florence, Italy, where she was studying. Doctors gave her a very low chance of survival. Her mother, Lilliana, went on a pilgrimage to Assisi and prayed at Carlo Acutis' tomb, asking for his intercession for her daughter's healing. On the same day, Valeria began to breath independently again, and recovered quickly. The Vatican recognized this miraculous healing, paving the way for Acutis to become a saint.

Please accept my deepest thanks for your prayers and continued financial support for our senior priests residing at St. Pius X Residence.



real life catholic

The following was written by **Chris Stefanick of Real Life Catholic** that I thought was worth sharing with you regarding the tragedy at Annunciation School/Church in Minneapolis last week:

"I suppose it's worth asking: what does prayer actually do for us in the face of human evil and tragedy? Where is God when this kind of thing happens? Does it prove that prayer is pointless?"

Let me tell you where God is in all of this...

Stories are coming out that most of the victims were older kids. The reason is that junior high kids were throwing the little ones to the ground to save them before hiding themselves.

I read one story of a junior high student throwing a younger classmate to the ground and using his body as a shield—and getting shot in the back. Thank God he's alive.

I want you to think of that much courage and grace—from a 13-year-old—being willing to lay down his life for someone he barely knows. Wanna know what prayer does? That's what it does. That's the kind of kid prayer makes.

At the risk of oversimplifying things, a life of prayer, grace, contemplation, and the help of a Christian community doesn't produce the kind of kid who writes "For the children" and "Where is your God?" on a gun magazine before shooting up a congregation full of children at Mass.

So, what's the point of prayer and a Christian community? It makes saints. That's the main point.

But there's more...It's also worth pointing out that in a shooting where everyone is in a fishbowl, unable to escape, where hundreds are shot at and only two died... that might be a not-so-small miracle.

But above all, even when God doesn't step in and protect us physically, a relationship with Him gives us a victory that people who live a graceless life can't grasp. When someone is killed in *odium fidei*—that is, "in hatred of the faith"—the one killed is a martyr. I think these children are martyrs. Like the Holy Innocents. And I hope the Church declares them martyrs.

Sure, lots of factors converged to produce this tragedy—just like lots of factors converged on Jesus' body the day He was crucified. But hatred of God is an undeniable motivating factor here.

And if those children were martyred, I think that right now they're in a place of unimaginable glory. That place where, Revelation tells us, God "*will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death, or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.*" (Rev 21:4) That's what prayer gets us.

And for those left behind, prayer gives us the only hope worth clinging to at a time like this—that the end of this life isn't the end of the story. Prayer is the only way that loved ones left behind keep standing.

So let us pray, because we have problems right now as a society that laws alone can't fix.


