



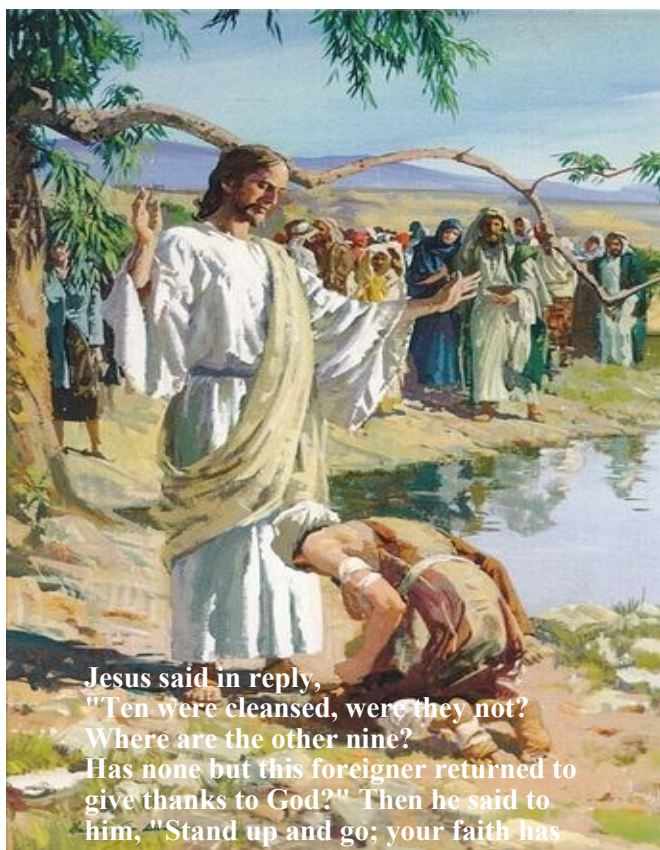

Dear Parishioners,



Monday's celebration of Columbus Day gives me the opportunity to write about the great Catholic men's organization of the Knights of Columbus.

I am proud to be a member and chaplain of our local Floral Park Council #2345.

This Council was founded over 100 years ago when their charter was granted on February 5, 1922. The original 70 members met on Feb. 8, 1922. Its first major task was to defend OLV parishioners and the Floral Park community from the influence of the KKK.

Here how it is described in our Centennial Journal (page 9):

On April 14, 1923, an outsider held a Ku Klux Klan meeting in Childs Hall - the same hall that served as a site for Sunday Mass for OLV parishioners. Shocked to learn that this meeting was to take place, members of the Knights of Columbus, including Floral Park Knights Council #2345, attended en masse to confront the speaker and refute his arguments.

*Dr. John H. Moore of Texas, speaking for the KKK, was soundly denounced by Knight Patrick Scanlon—who was also editor of the Brooklyn Diocesan newspaper **The Tablet** - as well as by local Knights and many parishioners. The KKK was also anti-Catholic, professing in the 1920s that Catholicism was incompatible with democracy. At the meeting, a resolution was passed overwhelmingly that the Klan was un-American and should have no place in Floral Park.*

Ever since those early days, the Knights of Columbus have been an organization that promoted the core values of charity, unity, fraternity and patriotism.

Christopher Columbus was chosen as the patron because he was a highly regarded Catholic lay man.

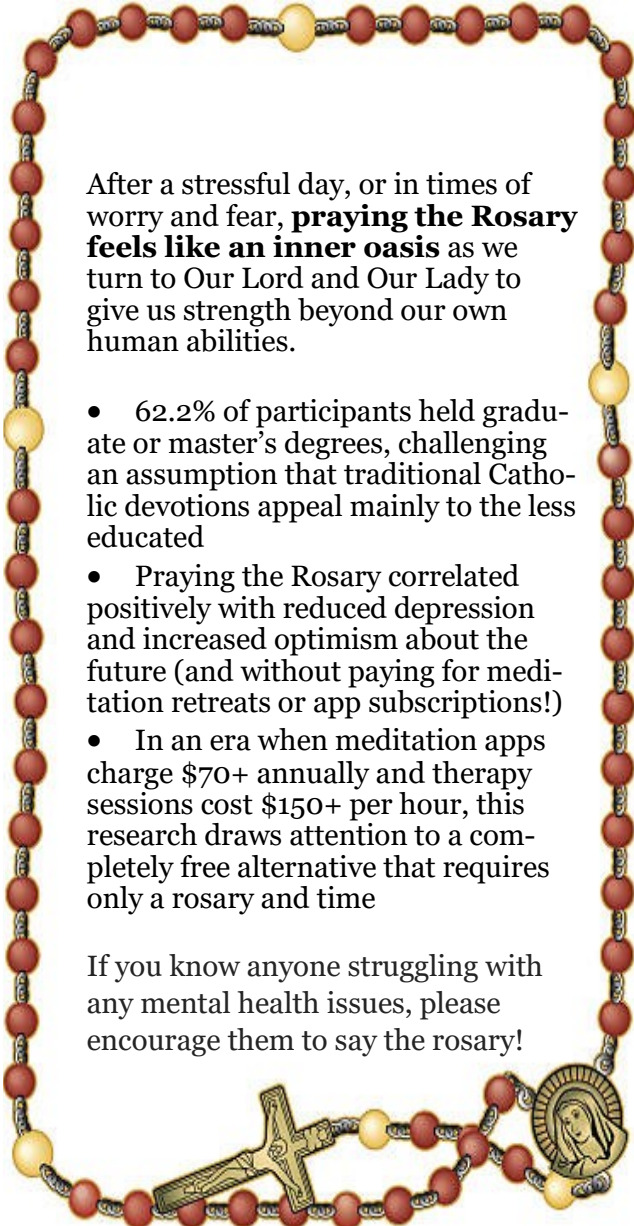

After a stressful day, or in times of worry and fear, **praying the Rosary feels like an inner oasis** as we turn to Our Lord and Our Lady to give us strength beyond our own human abilities.

- 62.2% of participants held graduate or master's degrees, challenging an assumption that traditional Catholic devotions appeal mainly to the less educated
- Praying the Rosary correlated positively with reduced depression and increased optimism about the future (and without paying for meditation retreats or app subscriptions!)
- In an era when meditation apps charge \$70+ annually and therapy sessions cost \$150+ per hour, this research draws attention to a completely free alternative that requires only a rosary and time

If you know anyone struggling with any mental health issues, please encourage them to say the rosary!
