

Recently we had an evening where approximately 40 people gathered to watch an interview by Bishop Barron entitled "Why are so many young people becoming Catholic?" I saw it as a positive message amidst all the bleak messages that we hear about faith and young people.

people to embrace their faith is through service trips and pilgrimages.

Campus ministry on many colleges offer service trips during semester breaks and during spring break. These are always worthwhile adventures for college students. They are exposed to a world that is very different from Long Island., New York. It's the good kind of mind-expanding that should characterize college days - rather than a bacchanal spring break or misdirected protests.

And for young adults after college, let me tell you about **The Camino** - a hiking pilgrimage in Europe ending at the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in Spain. Parishioner Raegan Fekert just returned from her 530 mile hike and shared her experience elsewhere in this bulletin. Please be sure to read it.



Anyone interested in learning more about **The Camino** can contact me at the rectory and I will put you in touch with Raegan.


These kinds of experiences are always enriching for a young person's personal, as well as spiritual development. Be adventurous - in a good way!

#### THE CAMINO

Walking over 500 miles through Spain was not something I ever thought I would do, but that's exactly what I did this summer. The Camino de Santiago, aka the Way of St. James, is a pilgrimage that leads to the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela, the final resting place of St. James the Apostle. There are many different routes, but I chose the French way, starting in Saint-Jean-Pied-de-Port, France and hiking over the Pyrenees Mountains into Spain. I walked a total of 530 miles, about 15 miles a day over 5 weeks. I went into this journey with big expectations: having revelations about my career path, processing grief, and discovering who I truly am as a person. I cannot say I got all the answers I wanted, but I gained much more.



I found beauty in the many churches we visited, taking in all of the unique art and magnificent religious statues. I felt connected to my faith through all of the blessings bestowed on us as "pilgrims," emphasizing the importance of letting go of our material goods and focusing on God's gifts to us. I received a blessing from a nun who gifted me a pendant of the Blessed Mother. I felt God in the conversations I had with people from all over the world, as we discussed our faith journeys while we hiked through hills and forests. I talked with people who felt comfort in being among fellow Catholics, as they did not have this religious freedom in their home nations. I felt peace in many stretches I walked alone, having the chance to slow down and spend time with my thoughts. I felt connected to God's creations, respecting all the animals I met and taking care of the environment around me. I also have a newfound appreciation for what I am both physically and mentally capable of. The heat and terrain were rough at points and the heavy weight of my backpack made it even more difficult, but I grew stronger with every step and welcomed the challenge.



Despite the intensity of the walk, life on the Camino felt so simple. You just take care of your basic needs: eating, walking, washing clothes, sleeping and repeat. Alongside all of that, there is lots of great conversation and fun times along the way, in the hostels, at pilgrims dinners, and at the many cappuccino stops. With very few distractions, my phone "screen time" was basically zero, and my main focus was on my personal journey and the genuine connections I was making around me.

I highly recommend the Camino de Santiago, no matter your age or activity level! I met people ranging in age from 18 to 80 years old, and everyone followed their own timeline. You can walk as fast or as slow as you need, and can even send your backpack ahead to lessen the stress on your body. At the end of the day, it is your Camino and you can do it in the way that works best for you.



People say that the real Camino begins when you get home and apply the principles you learned to "real life." This pilgrimage was such a beautiful, spiritual experience away from my everyday life but at the end of the day, I am still the same person here that I was in Spain. No matter how hard life is, I

know I have to keep moving forward, putting one foot in front of the other, just like during the Camino. And now that I am home, I am excited for my new "Camino" to begin.




