The next group that is being recognized and honored as part of the Jubilee Year of Hope this weekend are those involved in Education on all levels - from early education to ele-


mentary school and high school teachers to college professors to post-graduate educators.

New study reveals the rosary rivals modern meditation for mental health benefits

In an era where mindfulness apps dominate smartphones and meditation studios populate urban corners, a new groundbreaking international study suggests that the ancient Catholic prayer practice of praying the rosary may offer comparable mental health benefits to Easterninspired meditation techniques.



The research, published in the Journal of Religion and Health, also challenges assumptions Dray the made about traditional practices like the rosary, Posary revealing surprising insights about who is actually praying the rosary in 2025.

Researchers from Italy, Poland, and Spain surveyed 361 practicing Catholics to assess the impact of praying the rosary on well-being and mental health. They found that participants who prayed the rosary reported higher levels of well-being, increased empathy, and significantly lower levels of religious struggle or spiritual anxiety — which research has shown can be benefits of other meditation techniques.

The research also showed that praying the rosary correlated positively with reduced depression and increased optimism about the future. These effects rival those reported in studies of mindfulness meditation yet come without the sometimes hefty price tags of meditation retreats or app subscriptions.

Did you also know...

A new international study has found a stark link between early smartphone ownership and deteriorating mental health in early adulthood.




