

Dear Parishioners,

November 2nd is All Souls Day each year. Since it falls on a Sunday this year the whole Church is commemorating all the faithful departed.

Consider this scenario - we arrive at the gates of heaven and are being welcomed in - but when we look at ourselves we see that we're not clean - and so we don't want to go into eternity looking like that - so we ask to be able to get clean before entering. We ask for a period of purgation (purgatory) because we know we're not ready to enter heaven yet.

Purgatory is the gift to be able to "wash up" before entering the party! Our prayers for our beloved dead are our assistance to them in "washing up." Since we don't know how long that is going to take, we keep praying for our deceased loved ones as long as we are alive. We can say prayers, offer sacrifices, and have Masses said for them. May we never forget our beloved dead.

Practical considerations regarding Catholic Funerals:

I thought I would use this Feast of All Souls as an opportunity to review some very practical considerations regarding Catholic funerals.

- 1) Please be sure your family members know that you want a Funeral Mass upon your death especially if you know that your immediate family aren't church-goers and may deprive you of this grace.
- 2) Parishes vary in their policies regarding eulogies at Funeral Masses. Our policy at OLV is to allow one speaker at the beginning of the Funeral Mass to offer words of welcome and remembrance. Ideally these words would focus on the faith and family life of the deceased. Additional eulogies can be given at the wake service.
- 3) Cremation is permitted for Catholics. The clear preference is for the cremation to take place AFTER the Funeral Mass. If this is not possible, then the cremated remains may be present for the Funeral Mass.
- 4) Cremated remains are to be interred as soon as possible after the Funeral Mass to provide them with a final resting place.

 The remains should not be kept at home, scattered or divided up.



Did You Know!

A new international Global Mind Project study has found a stark link between early smartphone ownership and deteriorating mental health in early adulthood,.

Global Mind Project, led by Dr. Tara Thiagarajan of Sapien Labs, analyzed data from nearly two million people to understand how early exposure to smartphones and social media platforms affects long-term emotional, social, and cognitive functioning.

It reveals a consistent and troubling pattern: the earlier a child gets their first smartphone, the more severe their mental health struggles become by the time they reach early adulthood.

Among the most alarming findings: 46 percent of young women who got their first phones at ages five or six now report having suicidal thoughts, compared to just 26 percent of those who waited until 13 or older.

Mental well-being scores, measured on a scale incorporating 47 psychological functions, dropped dramatically based on the age of first smartphone use.


