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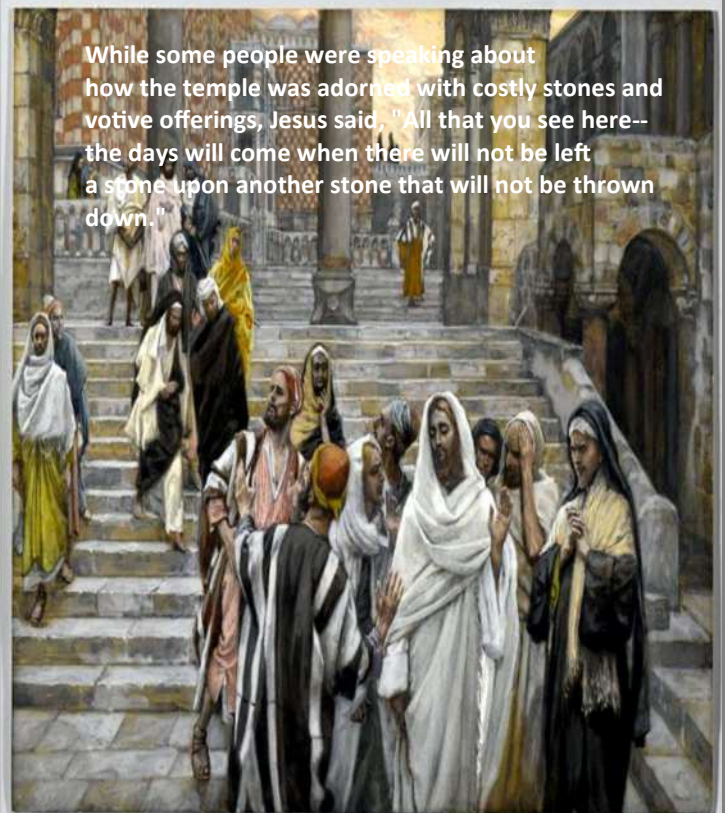

Global Mind Project\

Social Media . . .

The study found that though smartphones are the delivery mechanism, social media appears to drive much of the damage.

Social media access explains about 40 percent of the connection between early smartphone use and poor mental health outcomes. Cyberbullying (10 percent), disrupted family relationships (13 percent), and sleep disturbances (12 percent) also played significant roles, many of which exacerbated by social media platforms that encourage round-the-clock engagement.

Sleep, in particular, emerged as a critical factor. Children with early smartphone access often experience significant sleep disruption, not only from social media but from gaming, streaming and other screen-based activities.
