

This Sunday, the Third Sunday of Advent is called Gaudete Sunday - Sunday of JOY! We hear a lot about JOY in the prayers of Mass this weekend. The JOY theme is the reason for the rose colored vestments and Advent wreath candle.


Then there will be two Masses at 5:30 pm on Christmas Eve - in the church and in the chapel. And the Midnight Mass at midnight will be in the church.




