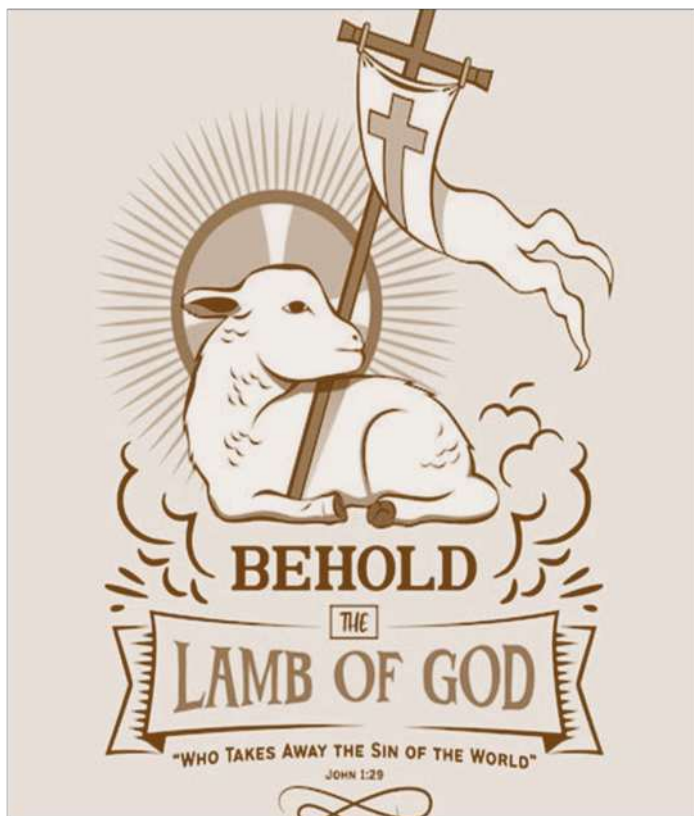

Dear Parishioners,

Respect for the dignity of ALL human life is a fundamental principle of our Catholic moral teaching. This week we have an opportunity to reflect on that theme in four specific ways: ecumenism, anti-racism, Christian persecution and the protection of unborn children.

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity

Throughout this week there will be prayer intentions for the unity of all Christian churches. It is an invitation to focus on what we share together - our common baptism and commitment to Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. The Priestly Prayer of Jesus in the Gospel of St. John explicitly prays that all His followers would be one. The separation within the Christian community is a scandal. We need to pray for all those who are working to resolve the conflicts and promote Christian unity. A step that we can each take would be to correct any prejudices against other Christian brothers and sisters that may reside in our hearts.

Martin Luther King Day-Monday, Jan. 19

Reverend Martin Luther King, Jr. was a Christian leader who worked for the recognition of the dignity of people of all races. That certainly reflects the Catholic principle of the dignity of all human life. So as we honor him as a nation on Monday, may we re-commit ourselves to the principle of the dignity of all human life, regardless of the color of our skin. Racism is a sin.

Feast of St. Agnes, Martyr - Jan. 21

This Wednesday is the feast of St. Agnes, the patroness of our diocese. She was a teen age virgin martyr of the first century. Her martyrdom is a reminder to us that men, women and children continue to be martyred for their Christian faith throughout the world, and this is happening in record numbers today. We might not experience it directly ourselves, but this is one of the most dangerous times in history to be a Christian. Pray and support persecuted Christians throughout the world.

Protection of Unborn Children

The blessed event of the overturning of Roe v. Wade in our country did not provide protection to unborn children - it just moved the decision to the States. Our own State of New York continues to be a place where many unborn children are aborted. Prayers and actions for their protection are still desperately needed. Thursday, January 22nd has been designated as a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children - consider coming to Mass on Thursday to pray for that intention.

Catholic Schools Week begins next Sunday, January 25th with the 10:30 am Mass. At that Mass we will celebrate as a parish community the rich blessing that Our Lady of Victory School is to our parish and local community.

Although the Church in Africa is growing, many still lack access to basic resources and pastoral care.

From the desk of Maureen . . .

On Friday, Pope Leo XIV issued his first "State of the World" address—a traditional annual speech that lays out the pope's priorities for the year.

In concept, the practice sounds similar to the American "State of the Union" address. But Pope Leo's speech differed in one fundamental way: Without mincing words or pursuing political correctness, he unapologetically, undeniably affirmed the sanctity of life.

"The vocation to love and to life... implies a fundamental ethical imperative for enabling families to welcome and fully care for unborn life," said Pope Leo.

He continued, "We categorically reject any practice that denies or exploits the origin of life and its development. Among these is abortion, which cuts short a growing life and refuses to welcome the gift of life."

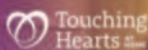
