What difference does a Catholic School make?

Young people today are inundated with a variety of messages about what's important in life. Regrettably, many of those messages are not helpful, and some even harmful, to the development of children.

A Catholic School environment assures parents that their children will hear only messages about life that are in conformity with Catholic Christianity.

New York State run, public schools, are religion-free zones. Our Lady of Victory is the exact opposite. Our religious faith is what gives our School its unique identity. I am grateful to all the parents who make that environment a priority for their children's formation.

In addition to an excellent academic education, a Catholic Elementary School education is so vital because it provides the foundation on which these children will build their entire spiritual lives. Faith provides meaning to life - that gift is invaluable - certainly worth the price of tuition!

The current tuition at Our Lady of Victory for one child is \$7050. If finances is the only reason your child is not attending OLV I would invite you to speak to me.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we celebrate Catholic Schools Week, I give thanks for the extraordinary gift of Catholic education and for the students, families, educators, clergy, and benefactors who make our schools thrive across Long Island.

This year's observance begins on *Word of God Sunday*, reminding us that Sacred Scripture is not merely studied, but proclaimed, prayed, and lived. 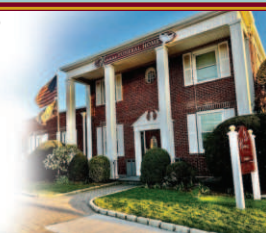
