









I'd like to share with you this letter I received from a college-age parishioner about her experience at **SEEK26** - a Catholic Conference for college students. It is another example of worthwhile opportunities for our young adults to deepen their faith!

Good Evening Fr. Tom,

I apologize for the late message; the chaos of beginning the semester has taken over! I wanted to thank you again for giving me the opportunity to attend SEEK26 in Fort Worth. I'd like to share a little bit about my experience on this trip!

This experience was intimidating at first, but quickly became so enriching and rewarding. On the first night, I was able to hear Keynote Speakers Fr. David Michael Moses and Sr. Miriam James, whose podcasts I had listened to before. Listening to these deeply relatable talks about relationship with Christ among 5,000 other people was very powerful. We received a video from Pope Leo, speaking to all the SEEK attendees and we were all star struck! Each morning of the conference began with Mass led by different bishops. The regular procession towards the altar was accompanied by around 200 priests. It was beautiful to have the support and guidance of all of these priests throughout the conference, who shared their knowledge and truly carried out their vocations. Confession was available each day for long windows of time and I was able to have one of the best, most powerful confessions I've ever had. On day 3 we had adoration for all 5,000 attendees and a beautiful procession all around the room with Jesus present in the monstrance.

I listened to talks by Sr. Miriam, Dr. Marguerite Duane, and Sarah Swafford that taught me a lot about my feminine identity in Christ and my identity as His daughter. Sr. Miriam's talk "Why Your Heart Aches" examined the empty promises of this world and the enemy, and how relationship with Christ is the only thing that will satisfy our hearts. I learned a lot about the Theology of the Body and faithfulness to God's design in Dr. Marguerite Duane's talk. One of my favorites was the women's talk from Sarah

Swafford. She theologically explained to us the importance of virtuous female friendship. Friends who will run with you towards the Lord.

On the third day, I was having a bit of a dry prayer experience, which was very discouraging. I wanted to feel Jesus' presence. He must've heard me because there was a talk scheduled that day by Brother Peter Xavier,



basically called "How to pray". Attending that talk, I was reminded how to seek Him in prayer: what to listen for, what questions to ask, etc... The last night concluded with Keynote Speakers Fr. Josh Johnson and Fr. Gregory Pine. These two men really ended SEEK on a high note. Their talks were humorous, relatable, wise, and striking. I really hope their talks are put online on the SEEK replay website for you to watch! (seekreplay.com)

I'm so grateful to have gone on this journey in my relationship with Christ. I have a great community at Christ the King at LSU, but this was a great reminder that the Catholic Church is universal and united in devotion to the Lord. It was a reminder that wherever I go after college, in my career, in life, I will never be alone. I have Jesus alongside me for eternity and the consistency of the celebration of the Mass! Again, thank you so much for giving me the chance to witness such a beautiful display of faith. It will stay with me forever.


