



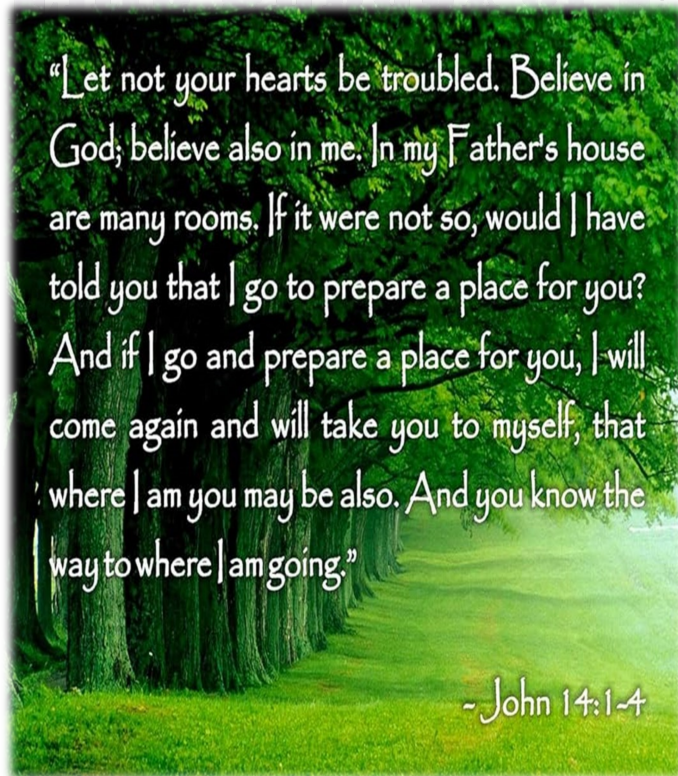

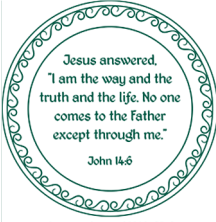
PARISH VISION STATEMENT

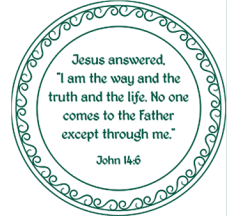

Dear Parishioners,

I want to tell you about our recent parish pilgrimage to France. But first I think I need to use a different word than “*pilgrimage*” to describe our adventure because “*pilgrimage*” implies some kind of challenge or struggle that goes along with the journey - and we had none of that. The plane rides went smoothly, the accommodations were comfortable, the meals were good, the company was enjoyable and the sights were spectacular! Other than one tripping mishap, everything went incredibly smoothly! So it was less of pilgrimage and more of a tour of religious sites.

The highlights for me were the daily Masses that I was privileged to celebrate.

* In Annecy at the tombs of St. Francis de Sales and St. Jane Frances de Chantal.

* In Ars at the Basilica of St. John Vianney, the Cure of Ars, and patron of parish priests. I saw the confessional where he sat for countless hours and I was able to go to Confession myself in that holy place.



* In Nevers in the presence of the incorrupt remains of St. Bernadette of Lourdes.

* In Lisieux at the Basilica of St. Therese, the Little Flower, after visiting her homes in Alencon and Lisieux, and the Carmel where she lived as a Carmelite nun.



* In Normandy at a church that lost its tower during the D-Day invasion. The trip to the Normandy Beach and the flag-lowering ceremony at the American Cemetery were awe-inspiring to consider the vastness of the sacrifices made in World War II.

* At the majestic Rouen Cathedral I was privileged to con-celebrate Sunday Mass with the gracious Archbishop of Rouen



* At the Shrine of the Miraculous Medal where the apparitions occurred to St. Catherine Laboure

* The final Mass I con-celebrated at Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris.

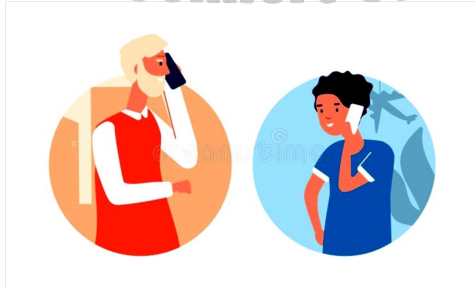
