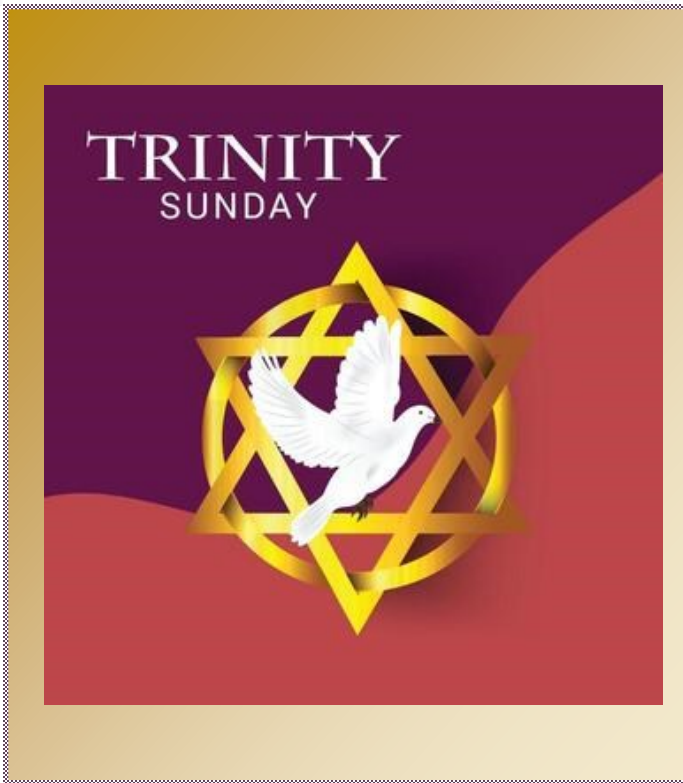

Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Last weekend we celebrated the Feast of Pentecost, the Feast of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the bond of love between the Father and the Son, in the mystery of the Holy Trinity that we celebrate this weekend. The primary symbol of God's love is the Sacred Heart of



Jesus. This year, on Thursday, June 11th, the vigil of the Feast of the Sacred Heart, the Bishops of the United States will be consecrating our country to the Sacred Heart of Jesus to mark the semiquincentennial anniversary of our nation.

In preparation for this consecration we will be praying a Novena to the Sacred Heart after each of the Daily Masses **beginning this Wednesday, June 3rd** and continuing to June 11th. Then on the Feast Day, Friday, June 12 we will have a Mass at 12 noon to celebrate the consecration. Msgr. Jim McNamara will be celebrant and preacher at this special Mass.

Next Weekend - Feast of Corpus Christi

Next weekend we will honor the greatest of all gifts on earth - the Body & Blood of Christ. The incredible way that Jesus gave us to reassure us that He would be with us always!

We will have a procession of the Blessed Sacrament after the 12 noon Mass next Sunday, June 7th. Benedictions will take place at the statues of the Blessed Mother on the rectory lawn and in the schoolyard. The final Benediction will take place in church. Please join us for this public display of our devotion to the Eucharist!



Also at the noon Mass next Sunday, new Ministers of Holy Communion will be installed.

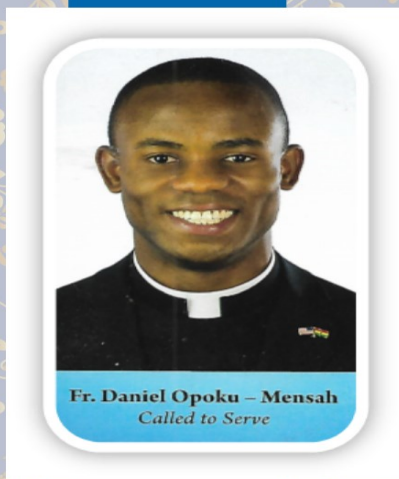
